### **Definition of Terms:**

**Consumer Price Index (CPI)** - an indicator of the change in the average retail prices of a fixed basket of goods and services commonly purchased by households relative to a base year.

**Inflation Rate** - year-on-year changes in the CPI. Labor Force Participation Rate - proportion of total labor force to the total household population 15 years and over

**Purchasing Power of Peso** – a measure of the value of the peso in a given period relative to a chosen reference period.

**Poverty Incidence** – the proportion of families/individuals with per capita income/expenditure less than the per capita poverty threshold to the total number of families/individuals.

**Subsistence Incidence** – the proportion of families/individuals with per capita income/expenditure less than the per capita food threshold to the total number of families/individuals.

**Employment Rate** - proportion of employed persons to the total labor force. Unemployment Rate - proportion of unemployed persons to the total labor force. **Underemployment Rate** - proportion of underemployed persons to total employed persons. Poverty Incidence among Population - refers to the proportion of population with per capita income less than the per capita poverty threshold to the total number of populations.
