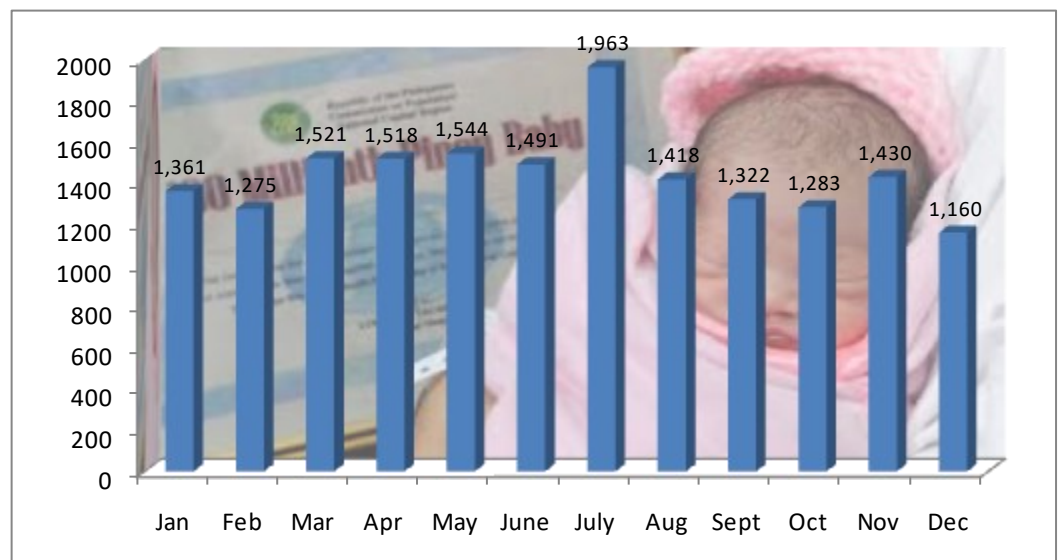

Compostela Valley Vital Statistics: 2016

Explanatory Notes

Vital statistics are derived from information obtained at the time when the occurrences of vital events and their characteristics are inscribed in a civil register. Vital acts and events are the births, deaths, fetal deaths, marriages, and all such events that have something to do with an individual's entrance and departure from life together with the changes in civil status that may occur to a person during his lifetime. Recording of these events in the civil register is known as vital or civil registration and the resulting documents are called vital records. The data on vital statistics presented in this special release were obtained from the reports of 11 Local Civil Registry Offices of Compostela Valley both timely and delayed registration.

Birth Statistics

The total registered Birth for the Province of Compostela Valley for the year 2016 totalled 17,286, while on the year 2015, the total registered birth totalled 16,418. The figure shows that the registration of birth increases by 868 or 5.29%. The month of July 2016 recorded having the highest number with 1,963 in terms of registration comprised of timely and delayed registration of birth, while the month of December 2016 registered the lowest number with 1,160 registration of birth.

Birth Statistics

Among the 11 municipalities of the Province, the highest number of registered birth in 2016 was recorded at the Municipality of Montevista with 3,882 registered birth or 22.46% of the total registered birth of the Province, followed by the Municipality of Pantukan having a totalled birth registration of 3,640 or 21.06%. On the other hand, the Municipality of Mawab recorded having the least birth registration for the year 2016 with a totalled registered birth of 480 or 2.78%.

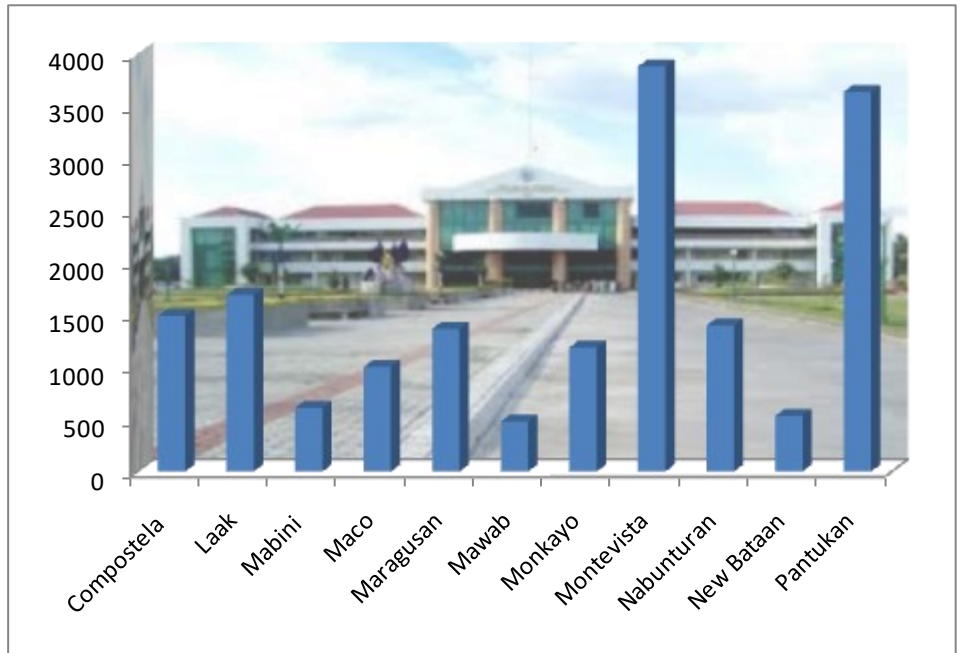
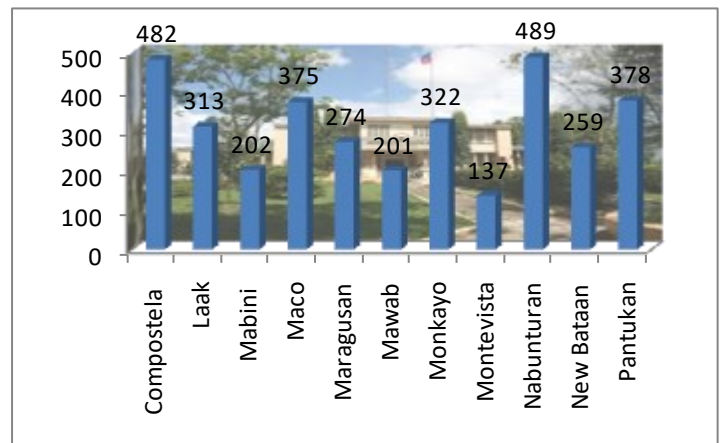
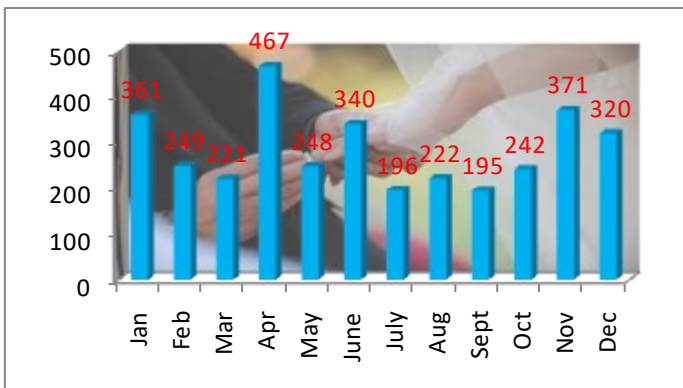


Figure 3. Number of Registered Marriage by Month of Occurrence in Compostela Valley Province: 2016

Marriage Statistics

There were 3,432 registered marriage recorded for the year 2016. The month of April 2016 recorded the highest registration for the entire year with a total registration of 467 or 13.61%. On the other hand, September 2016 had the least registration of 195 or 5.68%.

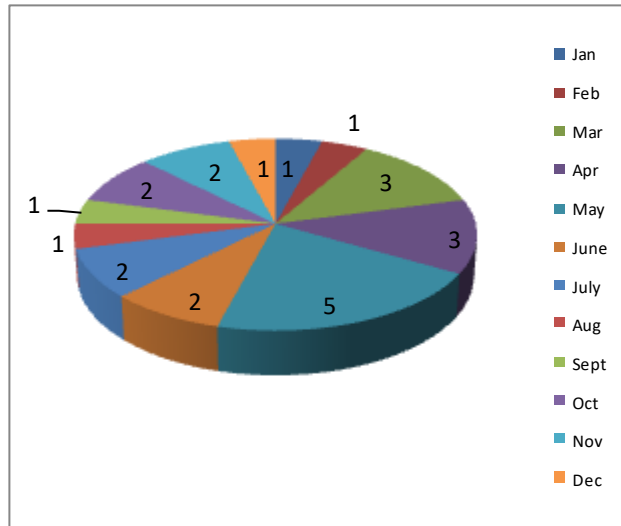
Marriage Statistics

Nabunturan got the highest registered marriage for the year 2016 totalled 489 or 14.25% of the total registered marriage for the entire year in the Province of Compostela Valley. It is then followed by Compostela with a total registered marriage of 482 or 14.04%. However, Montevista got the least registered marriage for the year 2016 with a total number of registered marriage of 137 or 3.99%.

Fetal Death Statistics

The Province of Compostela Valley registered 24 fetal death for the year 2016. Out of 11 municipalities of Compostela Valley, 6 Local Civil Registry Offices were able to register fetal death and Pantukan got the highest registration of 9, followed by Laak with 7 registration, Compostela and Nabunturan with 3 registered fetal death each and Mabini and Maco with 1 registered fetal death each. Laak recorded the highest registration of fetal death in a month specifically on May 2016 with 4 registered fetal death.

Figure 6. Number of Registered Death by Month of Occurrence in Compostela Valley Province: 2016

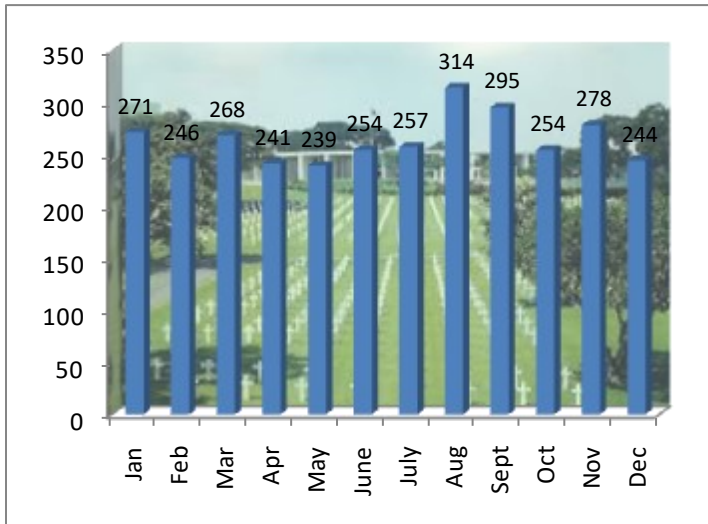
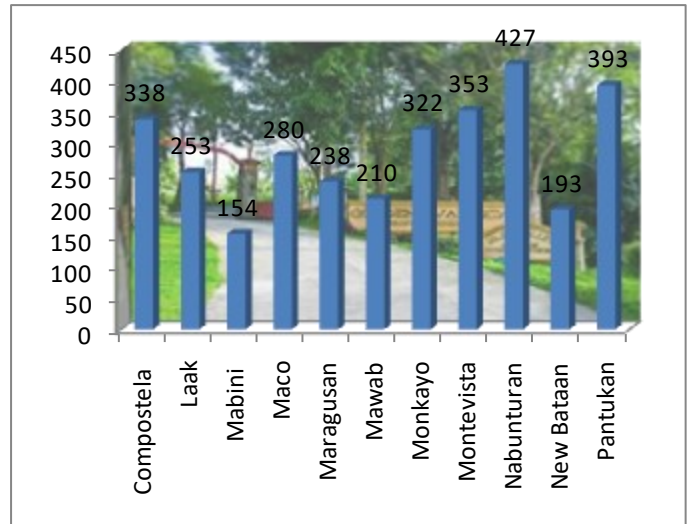


Figure 7. Number of Registered Death by Municipality in Compostela Valley Province: 2016



Death Statistics

A total of 3,161 registered deaths were reported in 2016 in the Province of Compostela Valley. The month of August 2016 registered the highest number of 314 or 9.93% while the month of May 2016 registered the least number of 239 or 7.56%.

Death Statistics

The Municipality of Nabunturan recorded to have the highest registered death of 427 or 13.51%, followed by Pantukan with a total registered death of 393 or 12.43%. On the other hand, Mabini got the least registered death of 154 or 4.87% of the total registered death for the entire Province of Compostela Valley.

DEFINITION OF TERMS

Live Birth is a complete expulsion or extraction from its mother of a product of conception, irrespective of the duration of the pregnancy, which after such separation, breathes or shows any other evidence of life, such as beating of the heart, pulsation of the umbilical cord, or definite movement of voluntary muscles, whether or not the umbilical cord has been cut or the placenta is attached; each product of such a birth is considered liveborn.

Marriage is a contract of permanent union between a man and a woman entered into in accordance with law for the establishment of conjugal and family life.

Death refers to the permanent disappearance of all evidence of life at any time after live birth has taken place (postnatal cessation of vital function without capability of resuscitation).

Fetal Death refers to death prior to the complete expulsion or extraction of a product of conception from its mother, irrespective of the duration of pregnancy; the death is indicated by the fact that after such separation, the fetus does not breathe or show any other evidence of life, such as beating of the heart, pulsation of the umbilical cord, and definite movement of voluntary muscles.
