(2012=100)

💡 This implies that the cost of a basket of goods and services commonly purchased by a typical Filipino household worth Php100.0 in 2012 in the Davao Region is worth Php128.8 in 2021.

The CPI is an indicator of the changes in the average retail prices of a fixed basket of goods and services commonly purchased by households relative to a base year.

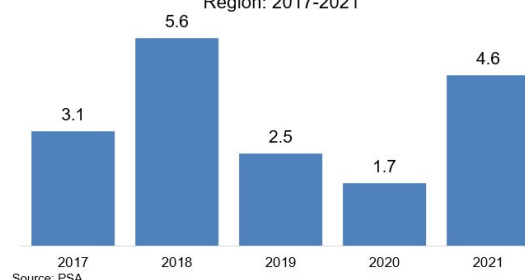

### Inflation Rate (2012=100)

Figure 1. Average Regional Inflation Rate, Davao Region: 2017-2021



The annual average inflation accelerated to 4.6 percent compared to 1.7 percent in 2020.

💡 Inflation Rate is the rate of change of the CPI expressed in percent. Inflation is interpreted in terms of declining purchasing power of peso.

### Purchasing Power of Peso (2012=100)



**0.78**

A peso in 2012 is worth 78 centavos in 2021.

💡 Purchasing Power of Peso gives an indication of how much the Philippine peso is worth in a given period relative to its value in a base period.
