This implies that the cost of a basket of goods and services commonly purchased by a typical Filipino household worth Php100.0 in 2012 in the Davao Region is worth Php128.8 in 2021.

The CPI is an indicator of the changes in the average retail prices of a fixed basket of goods and services commonly purchased by households relative to a base year.



### Inflation Rate (2012=100)



The annual average inflation accelerated to 4.6 percent compared to 1.7 percent in 2020.

Inflation Rate is the rate of change of the CPI expressed in percent. Inflation is interpreted in terms of declining purchasing power of peso.

## **Purchasing Power of Peso** (2012=100)



A peso in 2012 is worth 78 centavos in 2021.

Purchasing Power of Peso gives an indication of how much the Philippine peso is worth in a given period relative to its value in a base period.
