

## **TECHNICAL NOTES:**

**LIVE BIRTH** is a complete expulsion or extraction from its mother of a product of conception, irrespective of the duration of the pregnancy, which after such separation, breathes or shows any other evidence of life, such as a beating of the heart, pulsation of the umbilical cord, or definite movement of voluntary muscles, whether or not the umbilical cord has been cut or the placenta is attached; each product of such a birth is considered liveborn.

**MARRIAGE** is a contract of permanent union between a man and a woman entered into in accordance with law for the establishment of conjugal and family life.

**CERTIFICATE OF NO MARRIAGE (CENOMAR)** is a certification issued by the PSA stating that a person has not contracted any marriage. It is also called a Certificate of No Record of Marriage or Certificate of Singleness. In legal definitions for interpersonal status, a single person is someone who has never been married.

**DEATH** refers to the permanent disappearance of all evidence of life at any time after live birth has taken place (postnatal cessation of vital function without capability of resuscitation).
