
The headline inflation in the region continued its decline to 5.4 percent in September 2023 from 3.9 percent in August 2023.

INFLATION RATE

is the annual rate of change or on-year change in the **CONSUMER PRICE** INDEX (CPI) expressed in percent.

CPI

is an indicator of the change in the average retail prices of a fixed basket of goods and services commonly purchased by households relative to a base year. The CPI for All Income Households was rebased from Base Year 2012 to Base Year 2018

PURCHASING POWER OF PESO (...)
is a measure of the real value of peso in a period. It is computed by getting the reciprocal of the CPI and multiplying the result by 100.




