## **DEFINITION OF TERMS**

**Gross Domestic Product (GDP)** - is a comprehensive measure of economic activity. It measures the value of all final goods and services produced within the economy in a given period of time

**Consmer Price Index (CPI)** - is a measure of change in the average retail prices of a fixed basket of commodities or goods and services commonly purchased by the households relative to a base year or base period

Inflation Rate - the annual rate of change or the year-on-year change of the CPI expressed in percent

**Purchasing Power of Peso** – a measure of the value of the peso in each period relative to a chosen reference period

Labor Force Participation Rate - proportion of total labor force to the total household population 15 years and over.

 $\ensuremath{\textbf{Employment}}\xspace$  Rate - proportion of employed persons to the total labor force.

**Unemployment Rate** - proportion of unemployed persons to the total labor force.

**Underemployment Rate** - proportion of underemployed persons to total employed persons.
