## **DEFINITION OF TERMS**

**Gross Domestic Product (GDP)** - is a comprehensive measure of economic activity. It measures the value of all final goods and services produced within the economy in a given period of time

Consmer Price Index (CPI) - is a measure of change in the average retail prices of a fixed basket of commodities or goods and services commonly purchased by the households relative to a base year or base period

**Inflation Rate** - the annual rate of change or the year-on-year change of the CPI expressed in percent

**Purchasing Power of Peso** – a measure of the value of the peso in each period relative to a chosen reference period

**Labor Force Participation Rate** - proportion of total labor force to the total household population 15 years and over.

Employment Rate - proportion of employed persons to the total labor force.

**Unemployment Rate** - proportion of unemployed persons to the total labor force.

**Poverty Incidence**- the proportion of families/individuals with per capita income/expenditure less than the per capita poverty threshold to the total number of families/individuals

**Subsistence incidence-** the proportion of families/individuals with per capita income less than the per capita food threshold to the total number of
