

DEFINITION OF TERMS

Gross Domestic Product (GDP) - is a comprehensive measure of economic activity. It measures the value of all final goods and services produced within the economy in a given period of time

Consmer Price Index (CPI) - is a measure of change in the average retail prices of a fixed basket of commodities or goods and services commonly purchased by the households relative to a base year or base period

Inflation Rate - the annual rate of change or the year-on-year change of the CPI expressed in percent

Purchasing Power of Peso – a measure of the value of the peso in each period relative to a chosen reference period

 $\textbf{Labor Force Participation Rate} \ - \ \text{proportion of total labor force to the total household population 15 years and over.}$

Employment Rate - proportion of employed persons to the total labor force.

Unemployment Rate - proportion of unemployed persons to the total labor force.

Underemployment Rate - proportion of underemployed persons to total employed persons.

Poverty Incidence- the proportion of families/individuals with per capita income/expenditure less than the per capita poverty threshold to the total number of families/individuals

Subsistence incidence- the proportion of families/individuals with per capita income less than the per capita food threshold to the total number of
