A month-long celebration of the 28th NSM



Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 647 signed by then President Corazon C. Aquino on 20 September 1990 declaring the month of October every year as the National Statistics Month, PSA XI once again joined the celebration. This year's monthlong celebration in Davao Region was filled with lots of activities in collaboration with our partners from the regional and local agencies.

On 06 October 2017 at the Pinnacle Hotel and Suites, Davao City, the National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA) XI hosted the opening ceremony of the 28th NSM with the theme "Facts and Figures for the Future: Statistics for Evidence-Based Decisions Towards AmBisyon Natin 2040". Keynote speakers from NEDA Central Office, Philippine Information Agency (PIA), and Commission on Higher Education (CHED) XI delivered their messages on awareness and appreciation of the value of statistics among different sectors of society. - important role of reliable statistics and accurate information in establishing right strategies to track the progress towards AmBisyon Natin 2040 which envisioned Filipino families to enjoy matatag, maginhawa, at panatag na buhay.
- Several regional line-agecies, local government units, academe, and private sector displayed streamer conspicuous place of their offices for the whole month of October in support to the 28th NSM. Davao Region hosted the conduct of training/ regional accounts for workshop on PSA Mindanao regions on 24 to 25 October 2017 at the Marco Polo Hotel, Davao City. The two-day training aimed to orient the participants on the concepts and definitions, scope and coverage, estimation process and methodology of the System of National Accounts (SNA). It also explained the importance and interpretation of the economic variables and indicators generated from the regional accounts which focused on the Gross Regional Domestic Product (GRDP) and the Gross Regional Domestic Expenditure (GRDE).

The Macroeconomic Accounts Service (MAS) team of PSA, headed by Division Chiefs Florande S. Polistico of Production Accounts Division (PAD) and Mark C. Pascacio of Expenditure Accounts Division (EAD) together with the sector specialists, served as lecturers and facilitators in the training. Deputy National Statistician (DNS) on Sectoral Statistics Romeo S. Recide, in his message, emphasized the importance of regional accounts like GRDP which is one of the most requested data among planners, policy makers and various stakeholders.
