



Meanwhile, on January 22nd of this year, the Regional Development Council XI approved a memorandum and a resolution urging the designation of focal persons on Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in the national government agencies, local government units, state universities and colleges, and government-owned and controlled corporations through RDC XI Resolution No. 105, series of 2018.



The Statistical Operations and Coordination Division (SOCD) of PSA XI released its first quarter special releases on the Results of December 2018 Client Satisfaction Survey of CRS Davao Outlet, Livestock and Poultry Situation Report of Davao Region, and Results of the 2016 Annual Survey of the Philippine Business and Industry of Davao City.




Figure 1. Distribution of Establishments with TE of 20 and over by Region: 2016



On client's satisfaction survey result which is conducted every quarter, the outlet received an 85.5 percent satisfaction rating for the fourth quarter of 2018. This was done in order to assess the level of customer's service satisfaction which shall also serve as baseline for the improvement of offices' services. The livestock and poultry situation report of Davao City as of July 2018 was likewise released on January 21, 2019 which covered the regional inventory and production of livestock, chicken, and duck. Results on the 2016 Annual Survey of the Philippine Business and Industry of Davao City was officially released on February 19, 2019 which covered the total number of establishments with total employment of 20 and over in the formal sector .
