


RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this Resolution be furnished to concerned agencies and the PSA Central Office for information and appropriate action;

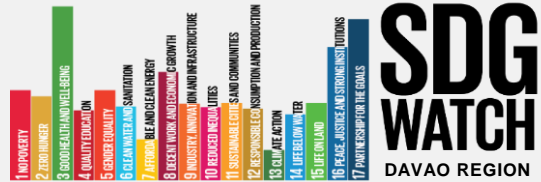

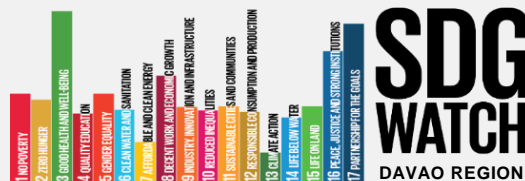
