RSC XI Resolution No. 3 Series of 2018

APPROVING THE ADOPTION OF CORE REGIONAL INDICATORS (CORE-IS) OF DAVAO REGION

WHEREAS, Article 6, Rule 5, Title II of R.A. 10625 (Philippine Statistical Act of 2013) mandates the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) to coordinate with government departments and local government units on the promotion and adoption of statistical standards involving techniques, methodologies, concepts, definitions, and classifications and avoidance of duplication in the collection of statistical information;

WHEREAS, the First Regional Statistics Committee Summit on September 21, 2016 underscored the need to develop standardized region-specific indicators that are comparable across regions to supplement key development indicators, such as the gross regional domestic product;

WHEREAS, the PSA Board passed Resolution No. 10, s. 2017, approving the adoption of the Core Regional Indicators (CoRe-Is) that shall monitor the social, economic, political, cultural and environmental developments at the regional level to aid the government in understanding the needs of local communities and in making evidence-based decisions for planning and policy formulation;

WHEREAS, the initial list of CoRe-Is for Davao Region was presented to this Committee during its meetings in September 2016 and July 2017 and was consequently validated by the members;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the adoption of the attached set of Core Regional Indicators (*Annex A*) in Davao Region be approved;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that this Committee take charge of overseeing the implementation, review and updating of Core-Is to monitor the attainment of regional goals and targets and to elevate to the PSA Board any issue on CoRe-Is generation that cannot be resolved at the subnational level.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the PSA Regional Statistical Services Office (RSSO) XI be enjoined to include matters on CoRe-Is generation and accessibility in this Committee's quarterly meetings; regularly compile and disseminate CoRe-Is data; and publish the same in the Regional Social and Economic Trends XI.

WHEREAS, the Department of Statistics (DOS) of the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) is coordinating with provincial departments and local government units on the development of statistical standards involving concepts, methodologies, concepts, definitions and classifications and avoidance of duplication in the collection of statistical information;

WHEREAS, the First Regional Statistics Committee (RSC I) of the PSA has understood the need to develop standardized statistical standards and concepts for the Davao region to supplement key data for the region's statistical products;

WHEREAS, the PSA Board passed Resolution No. 10, s. 2017, approving the adoption of the Core Regional Indicators (CoRe-Is) that will monitor the social, economic, cultural and environmental developments of the region to aid the government in understanding the needs of local communities and in making evidence-based decisions for planning and policy formulation;

WHEREAS, the initial list of CoRe-Is for Davao Region was presented to the Committee during its meetings in September 2016 and July 2017 and was unanimously adopted by its members;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the PSA Regional Statistical Service Office (RSSCO) be required to include matters on CoRe-Is generation and availability in its Committee's quarterly meetings, regularly compile and disseminate CoRe-Is data, and publish the same in the Regional Social and Economic Trends XI;
