REGISTERED LIVE BIRTHS IN DAVAO DE ORO, 2019

Data on births presented in this release were obtained from the Certificates of Live Birth, (Municipal Forms No. 102), that were registered at the Office of the City/Municipal Civil Registrars all throughout the country and forwarded to the Philippine Statistics Authority. Information presented include registered births which occurred from January to December 2019. Cumulative figures for 2019 reflect updated data received from previous months and may differ from preliminary counts previously published.

Fourteen births per thousand population

In 2019, a total of 10,494 live births were registered in Davao de Oro, which is equivalent to a crude birth rate (CBR) of 13.7 or 14 births per thousand population.¹

On the average, about 29 babies were born daily and it is equivalent to 1 baby born per hour.

More males born than females




Figure 1. Percent Distribution of Registered Live Births by Sex, Davao de Oro: 2019

In 2019, more males (5,426 or 51.70%) were born than females (5,068 or 48.30%) resulting in sex ratio at birth of 107 males per 100 females. (Figure 1) On the other hand, in the municipality of Maragusan it was recorded that more females were born than males. (Table 1)








Highest occurrence of births recorded in Montevista

Areas with hospitals relatively reported the highest number of live births by place of occurrence. Of the total live births, 35.68 percent were born in Montevista, 22.97 percent in Pantukan, 9.82 percent in Laak, and 7.95 percent in Maragusan. (Figure 2)

Most number of births registred in October


In 2019, most registered births occurred in October at 997 or 9.50% of the total births in Davao de Oro. It was followed by the months of December (9.28% share), September (9.10%), and November (8.90%). On the other hand, the month of February had the least number of births (7.14%).



In terms of daily average, October recorded the highest with an average of of 32 births per day, which translates to 1 birth per hour. On the contrary, June had the lowest daily average number of births with 26, equivalent to 1 birth per hour. (Table 2)






Nine in ten birth deliveries were medically attended

Of the total number of births in the country, 97.62 percent were attended by health proffesionals and 2.15 percent were attended by traditional birth attendant. In figure 4 shows the comparison between the deliveries by place of occurrence and the usual residence of the mother.
