HOUSING CHARACTERISTICS IN DAVAO REGION (Results of the 2015 Census of Population)

Occupied Housing Units in Davao Region reached 1,159,719

The number of occupied housing units in Davao Region as of August 1, 2017 was 1,159,719. This is 167,990 higher than the 991,729 occupied housing units reported in May 1, 2010 and 420,299 more than the 739,420 occupied housing units posted in May 1, 2000.

There are 102 Households for every 100 Occupied Housing Units

A total of 1,177,409 households and 4,866,957 persons resided in 1,159,719 housing units in Davao Region. This results to a ratio of 102 households for every 100 occupied housing units and a ratio of 4.20 persons per occupied housing units.

Ratio of households to occupied housing units is almost the same in the provinces, 101 – 102 households per 100 occupied housing units.

On the other hand, Davao del Sur (excluding Davao City) posted the lowest ratio of household population to occupied housing units of 4.01, while Davao Oriental posted the highest household population to occupied housing units of 4.39 among provinces in the region.

Majority were Single-type houses

Single houses made up of 85.5 percent of the total occupied housing units in Davao Region in 2015. About 7.5 percent were multi-unit residential type and 6.6 percent were duplex type.

Majority of the Occupied Housing Units had Outer Walls Made of Concrete/brick/stone

In 2015, about 3 in every 10 occupied housing units in Davao Region had outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone (31.08 percent). Bamboo/sawali/cogon/nipa as outer walls made up of a quarter of the occupied housing units in the region (25.66 percent).

Among provinces, occupied housing units whose outer walls are made of concrete/brick/stone are predominant in Davao City (43.06 percent) and Davao del Norte (35.05 percent). Bamboo/sawali/cogon/nipa as material of outer walls of the occupied housing units are predominant in Davao Occidental (68.63 percent), Davao Oriental (38.53 percent) and Davao del Sur (36.05 percent). Majority of the occupied housing units in Compostela Valley have wood as construction material of the outer walls (30.37 percent).

Majority of the occupied housing units had roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum

Of the 1,259,719 occupied housing units in the region in 2015, 80.66 percent had roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum. Bamboo/sawali/cogon/nipa as roof made up of a 13.52 percent of the occupied housing units in the region.

Galvanized iron/aluminum is the predominant roof material in all provinces (Davao City, 89.79 percent; Compostela Valley, 86.76; Davao del Norte, 85.39 percent; Davao del Sur, 79.62 percent; Davao Oriental 68.53 percent) except in Davao Occidental, where occupied housing units had bamboo/sawali/cogon/nipa as roof (67.11 percent).

Eight in 10 of the households in the region have electricity for lighting

Electricity is the main fuel for lighting in the region in 2015, where 81.98 percent of the 1,177,409 households reported having electricity for lighting. However, there are still 487 households in the region did not use any fuel for lighting

Majority of the households in all provinces reported electricity for lighting (Davao City, 92.77 percent; Davao del Norte, 84.95 percent; Davao del Sur, 84.32 percent; Davao Oriental, 74.46 percent; and Compostela Valley, 73.48 percent) except Davao Occidental where almost half of the households (46.83 percent) reported Kerosene as their fuel for lighting and 42.20 percent of the households have electricity as their fuel for lighting

Three out of 10 of the households reported own use faucet, community water system as their main source of water for drinking

In 2015, majority of the households (31.92 percent) reported that they get their drinking water from own use faucet, community water system, while 18.05 percent get their drinking water from shared faucet community water system and 13.17 percent from shared tubed/piped deep well.

More than half of the households in Davao City (54.19 percent) reported own use faucet, community water system as their main source of drinking water. In Davao del Norte, 1 out of 4 households (25.70 percent) reported bottled water as their main source of water for drinking. On the other hand, almost a quarter of the households in Davao

Occidental (23.76 percent) and Davao Oriental (23.49 percent) reported shared tubed/piped deep well as their source of drinking water.

Two out of 5 of the households reported own use faucet, community water system as their main source of water for cooking

About 40 percent of the 1,177,409 households in the region reported own use faucet, community water system as their main source of water for cooking in 2015. Another 20 percent of the households reported shared faucet community water system.

About 80 percent of the households in Davao City reported to have community water system (own use and shared faucets) as their main source of water for cooking. Davao Occidental, on the other had reported shared tubed/piped deep well as the main water source for cooking (23.60 percent).
