PSA organizes 2nd Level LFH Training



The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) organized a Second Level Training for 2017 Listing of Farm Households (LFH) on August 22-26, 2017 at the Grand Regal Hotel, Lanang, Davao City. The 5-day training for Team Supervisors (TS) was crucial in order to enable them on the conduct of the survey.

The 2017 LFH aims to update the sampling frame for agricultural surveys conducted by the PSA and come up with an updated list of households engaged in agricultural activities as well as to develop the list of agricultural operators.

Throughout Davao Region, a total of 45 LFH TS were trained (4 from Davao Occidental, 20 from Davao del Sur, 6 from Davao del Norte, 7 from Compostela Valley, and 8 from Davao Oriental). Aside from SSS Ma. Leah Magracia and RO1 Nova Vicente, there were also 2 invited trainers from the Central Office.

SOCD cascades Operational Training for Crops Surveys

SOCD XI held its 2nd Level Operational Training for Crops Surveys on August 1-3, 2017 at the Training Room of PSA-RSSO XI. This was participated in by some selected regional and provincial AgStat focal persons.

The trainers for this activity were the following staff who attended the 1st level training in Quezon City on May 28-June 3, 2017, namely: 1.) Rachel R. Saguibo, 2.) Roel S. Domo, and 3.) Cristito N. Andales. The topics on the first day were focused on the survey methodology, data processing and data review of Palay and Corn Production Survey (PCPS). The discussions for the second day highlighted on the Palay and Corn Stocks Survey (PCSS) and Monthly Palay and Corn Situation Reporting System (MPCSR). On the third day, the lecture cen-



tered on the Crops Production Survey (Crps) and the Enhanced Information System for Palay (EISP). With the given time, the participants had an opportunity to raise their issues and concerns through an open forum.



RSC XI conducts 2017 Second Regular Meeting



The Regional Statistics Committee (RSC) XI held its 2nd Regular Meeting for the year on July 17 at the Conference Hall, NEDA-RDC XI Bldg., Davao City. This was attended by the members of the committee from regional line agencies (RLAs), local government units (LGUs), academe and private sector.

The meeting was presided by the NEDA XI Regional Director and RSC XI Chairperson, Maria Lourdes D. Lim. During this meeting, the RSC XI passed and approved one resolution on reconstituting the membership of the Regional Statistics Committee of Davao Region in which representation of the member agencies shall be the Regional Directors or Heads of the offices.

PSA XI OIC Regional Director and RSC XI Vice-Chairperson, Ruben D. Abaro, Jr. presented the initial list of CoRe-IS with additional and replacement indicators suggested by the PSA Board members for comments and inputs from the source agencies. Also, PSA-RSSO XI SOCD Chief and RSC XI Secretary, Rosendo M. Aya-ay, presented the RSDP which is a document that contains and identifies statistical activities of line agencies and LGUs in the region. NEDA XI PMID Chief Mario Realista reported the 2016 Progress Report on the attainment of targets vis-à-vis the annual and end-of-plan targets of the previous Davao Regional Development Plan (DRDP) 2011-2016, and the development targets and indicators of the current DRDP 2017-2022 along with its accompanying documents the Davao Regional Investment Program and Results Matrix (RMs), while PSA XI Information Officer Maria Vaneza P. Te presented the 2016 Report on the Economic Performance of Davao Region.

The RSC XI regularly conducts meeting to ensure continuity of its mandate to provide direction and guidance to regional/local statistical development activities.
