Regional Forum of Local Civil Registrars

A regional forum for Local Civil Registrars (LCR) was organized by the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Regional Statistical Services Office (RSSO) – Davao Region on 27 September 2019 at PSA Training Room. The activity is intended to review the practices of the LCR in connection to the implementation of Civil Registration Laws involving registration of birth, marriage, and death so as to institutionalize the implementation of the said laws.

OIC-RD Pepito D. Amoyen welcomed all the participants from the LCR from the different Local Government Units (LGUs). The rationale of the survey was presented by Statistical Specialist II (SS II) Filomeno F. Alas, Jr. while Supervising Statistical Specialist (SSS) Ma. Leah C. Magracia discussed the Status of Birth Registration: the 2015 Scenario. Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) Imelda A. Agustin presented the result of the survey of Civil Registration in Davao Region. It was immediately followed by a discussion of the Regional Director of PSA X Ruben D. Abaro, Jr. on the salient point of the survey.

1st Semester 2019 Meeting of the Sub-Committee on Migration and Development



CSS Rosendo M. Aya-ay attended the First Semester 2019 Meeting of the Sub-Committee of SDC XI on Migration and Development on the 5th of July 2019 at the Convention Hall of the NEDA-RDC XI Center, Bangkal, Davao City. He presented the results of the 2018 Survey on Overseas Filipinos (SOF) while NEDA XI presented the Updates on the Global Compact for Safe, Orderly and Regular Migration and Creation of the Department of Overseas Filipino Workers /Migration and Development. Presented also was the Results of the Multi-Stakeholders' Workshop & Philippine National Implementation Plan for the Global Compact on Migration.

National Statistician (NS) Hour and Turn Over of Responsibilities

Field Visit and Validation

On August 12-16, 2019, a field visit and validation for the disaggregation of crops, livestock and poultry, fisheries, and price statistics in the provinces of Davao Occidental and Davao del Sur was conducted. The participants included PSA personnel from Central Office (CO), RSSO Davao Region and PSOs of the two provinces. They were group into two: one to validate in Davao del Sur and the other one in Davao Occidental. The field visit aimed to review, validate, and finalize the disaggregated statistics on crops, livestock and poultry, and fisheries from 2016 to



2018 for Davao Occidental, the newly created province (NCP) and Davao del Sur, the mother province (MP). The validated data will be used for the review and validation of the results of the agricultural surveys with the new set of samples for both the NCP and MP in 2019 onwards.



2019 Mid-Year Performance Review and General Assembly

Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Regional Statistical Services Office (RSSO) – Davao Region conducted the 2019 Mid-Year Performance Review and General Assembly last 24 to 26 July 2019.
