

As of March 31, 2023, Davao de Oro has distributed ePhillD to 111,459 individuals, accounting for 17.9% of the total registered persons in the Step 2 of the registration process of 622,772 individuals.

## ePhillD is a:


- A digital version of the PhilID card that is printed on paper to serve as a temporary solution for individuals while waiting for the original PhilID card.
- Allows individuals to immediately access financial and social protection services that require proof identity.
- The information on the printed ePhilID is the same as the physical PhilID card including demograpic data. photograph, **Philsys** Card Number. generation date, and QR code.
- Distribution started last October 03, 2023.

#### What is **Philsys?** PHILIPPINÉ **IDENTIFICATION Z**SYSTEM

The Philippine Identification System (PhilSys) established through Republic Act 11055, is the single national identification system for all Filipinos and resident aliens




#### Number of ePhillD Distributed per Municipality



The highest number of ePhillD distributions was recorded in the Municipality of Monkayo with a total of 13,723, while Mawab had the lowest with 6,547 distributions.
