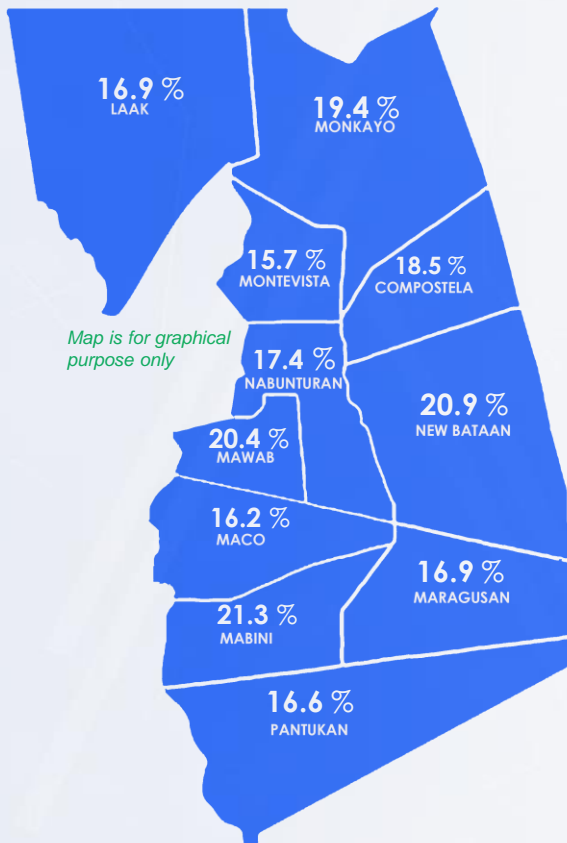

DAVAO DE ORO 17.9% Received ePhilID

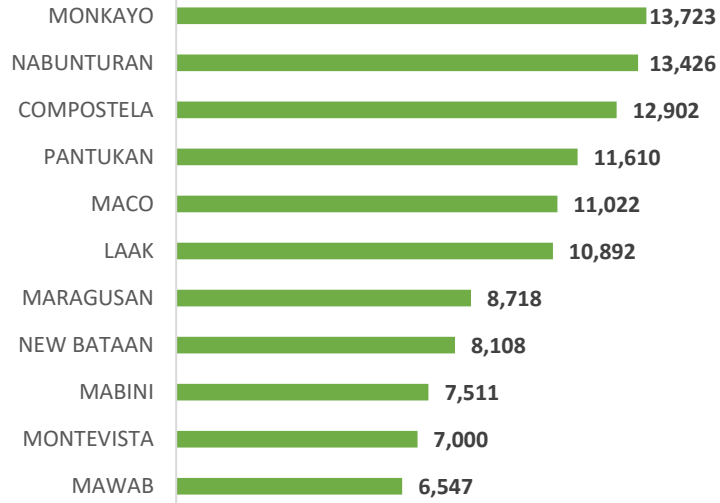
As of March 31, 2023, Davao de Oro has distributed ePhilID to **111,459 individuals**, accounting for **17.9%** of the total registered persons in the Step 2 of the registration process of **622,772 individuals**.

Number of ePhilID Distributed per Municipality

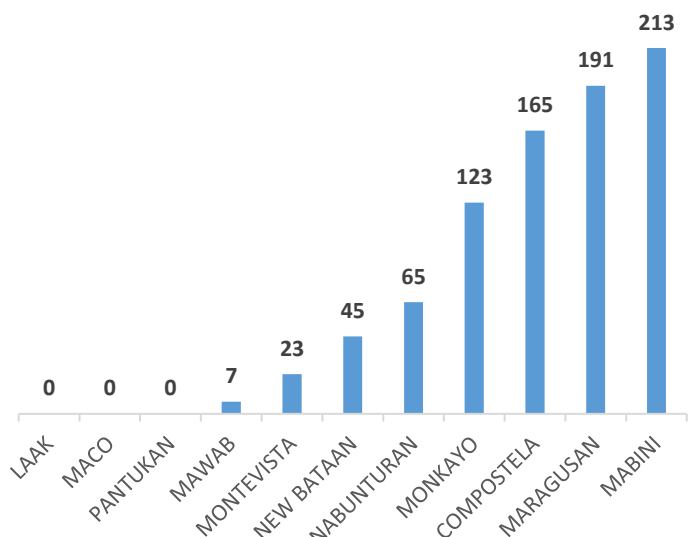

The highest number of ePhilID distributions was recorded in the Municipality of Monkayo with a total of **13,723**, while Mawab had the lowest with **6,547** distributions.

ePhilID Distribution Output

For the Month of March 2023



The highest number of ePhilID distributions output was recorded in the Municipality of Mabini with a total of **213**, while the Municipalities of Laak, Maco and Pantukan had no distribution output.

ePhilID is a:

- A digital version of the PhilID card that is printed on paper to serve as a temporary solution for individuals while waiting for the original PhilID card.
- Allows individuals to immediately access financial and social protection services that require proof of identity.
- The information on the printed ePhilID is the same as the physical PhilID card including demographic data, photograph, PhilSys Card Number, generation date, and QR code.
- Distribution started last October 03, 2023.

What is Philsys ?



The Philippine Identification System (PhilSys) established through Republic Act 11055, is the single national identification system for all Filipinos and resident aliens.
