

INFLATION IN DAVAO DEL NORTE LOWEST IN AUGUST 2019

Consumer Price Index (CPI) is the average retail price of a fixed basket of consumer goods and services commonly purchased by a Filipino household relative to the base year, 2012. The year-on-year change in CPI is referred to as the inflation rate. Davao del Norte CPI changed from 120.9 in August 2018 to 122.0 in August 2019, resulting to the lowest inflation recorded to date of 0.9 percent.

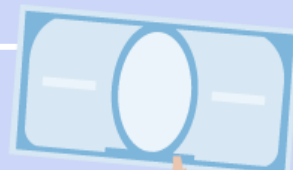
