

# DAVNOR INFLATION SLIGHTLY INCREASES TO 4.0 IN MARCH 2022

Consumer Price Index (CPI) is the average retail price of a fixed basket of consumer goods and services commonly purchased by a Filipino household relative to the base year, 2018. The year-on-year change in CPI is referred to as the inflation rate. With the CPI settling at 111.5, Davao del Norte's year-on-year headline inflation rate slightly increases to 4.0 percent in March 2022.
