Total population of **SANTA CRUZ** as of **12:01 AM, MAY 1, 2020**



The population of Santa Cruz grew faster during the period 2015-2020 with a Population Growth Rate (PGR) of 2.25% compared to 2.21% for the period 2010-2015.

Assuming that the population growth rate of 2.25% will remain constant, the municipality's population is expected to double in **31.4 YEARS**.



In 2020, the population density of the municipality is **316 persons per square kilometer**. This translates to an additional 32 persons (11.1 percent) from the 284 persons per square kilometer in 2015.

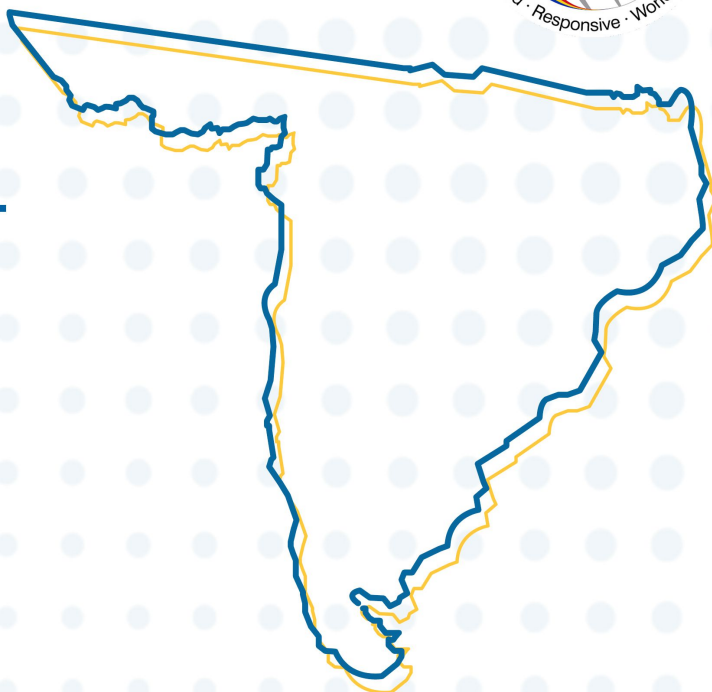

Santa Cruz's population comprises 14.9% of the total population of Davao del Sur.

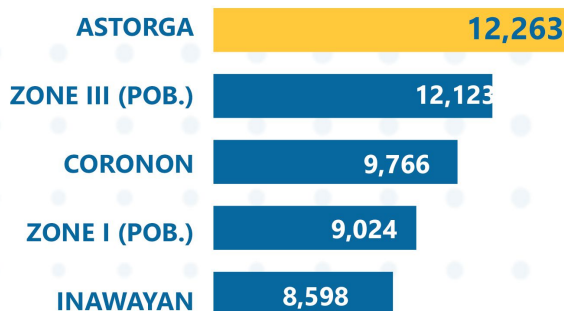

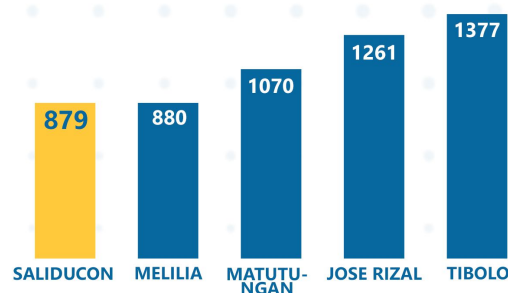
This means for every 1000 person in Davao del Sur, 149 resides in Santa Cruz.
