DAVAO DEL SUR

REPUBLIC ACT 8425 OF 1997 (SOCIAL REFORM & POVERTY ALLEVIATION ACT)

DEFINES POOR AS "INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES WHOSE INCOME FALL BELOW THE POVERTY THRESHOLD AS DEFINED BY THE NEDA AND/OR CANNOT AFFORD IN A SUSTAINED MANNER TO PROVIDE THEIR MINIMUM BASIC NEEDS OF FOOD, HEALTH, EDUCATION, HOUSING AND OTHER ESSENTIAL AMENITIES OF LIFE." (SECTION 3 OF THE RA 8425)

POVERTY THRESHOLD

THE MINIMUM INCOME REQUIRED FOR A FAMILY OR INDIVIDUAL TO MEET THE BASIC FOOD AND NON-FOOD REQUIREMENTS, ALSO KNOWN AS THE POVERTY LINE.

POVERTY INCIDENCE

THE PROPORTION OF FAMILIES/INDIVIDUALS WITH PER CAPITA INCOME LESS THAN THE PER CAPITA POVERTY THRESHOLD TO THE TOTAL NUMBER OF FAMILIES/INDIVIDUALS.

FOOD THRESHOLD

THE MINIMUM INCOME REQUIRED FOR A FAMILY/INDIVIDUAL TO MEET THE BASIC FOOD NEEDS, WHICH SATISFIES THE NUTRITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ECONOMICALLY NECESSARY AND SOCIALLY DESIRABLE PHYSICAL ACTIVITIES.

SUBSISTENCE INCIDENCE

PROPORTION OF FAMILIES/INDIVIDUALS WITH PER CAPITA INCOME LESS THAN THE PER CAPITA FOOD THRESHOLD TO THE TOTAL NUMBER OF FAMILIES/INDIVIDUALS EQUAL TO THE PROPORTION OF THE FOOD POOR.

Back estimation of the 2018 first semester was made due to the adoption of the 2018 Census of Population (POCEN 2015) results for the weights used in the Family Expenditure Survey (FIES) and the urban-rural classification of barangays.
