


As of 31 December 2024, 137,175 National ID-registered individuals in Davao de Oro received the digital copy of their National ID, also known as National ID in Paper. This accounts for 20.1 percent of the **683,946** individuals registered to the National ID Step 2 registration in the province.

In 2024, the highest number of National ID in Paper issuance was recorded in the Municipality of Nabunturan at 5,344, while the Municipality of Maco had the lowest with 46 issuances.
