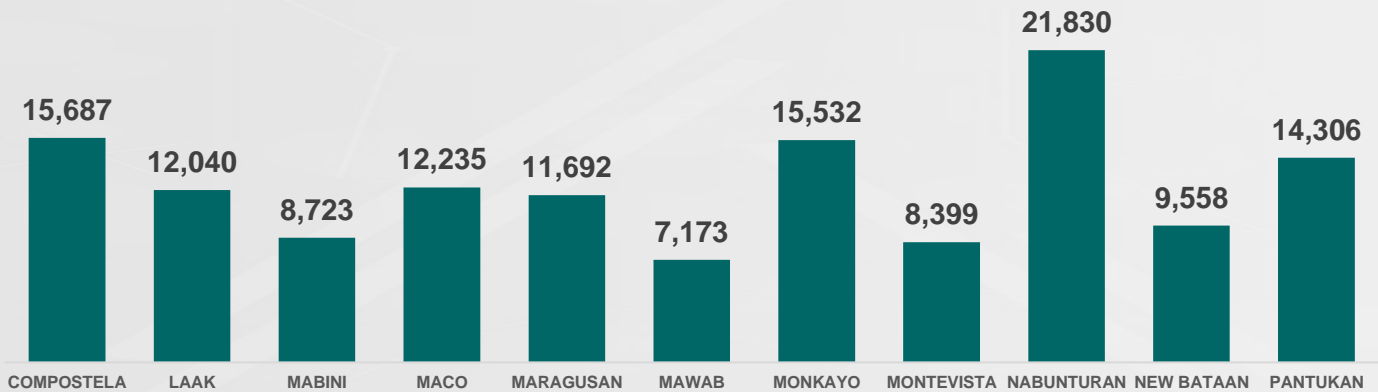

As of 31 December 2024, **137,175** National ID-registered individuals in Davao de Oro received the digital copy of their National ID, also known as National ID in Paper. This accounts for **20.1** percent of the **683,946** individuals registered to the National ID Step 2 registration in the province.

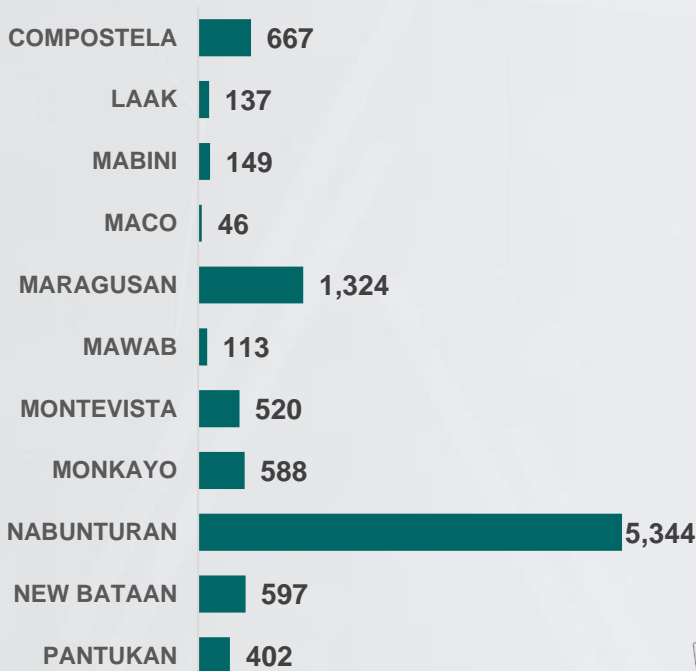
Figure 1. Number of National ID in Paper Issued per Municipality: Davao de Oro

The highest number of National ID in Paper issuance was recorded in the Municipality of Nabunturan with a total of **21,830**, while Mawab had the lowest with **7,173** issuances.

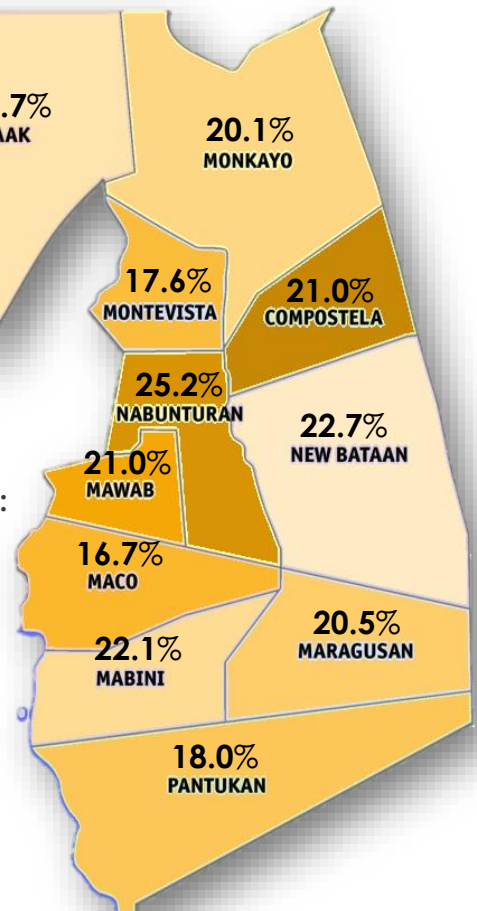
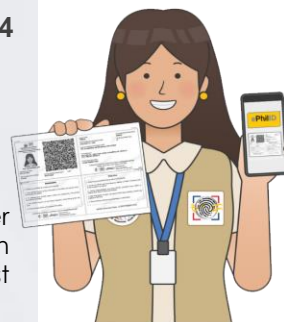
Figure 2. National ID in Paper Issuance per Municipality: Davao de Oro, 2024



In 2024, the highest number of National ID in Paper issuance was recorded in the Municipality of Nabunturan at **5,344**, while the Municipality of Maco had the lowest with **46** issuances.
