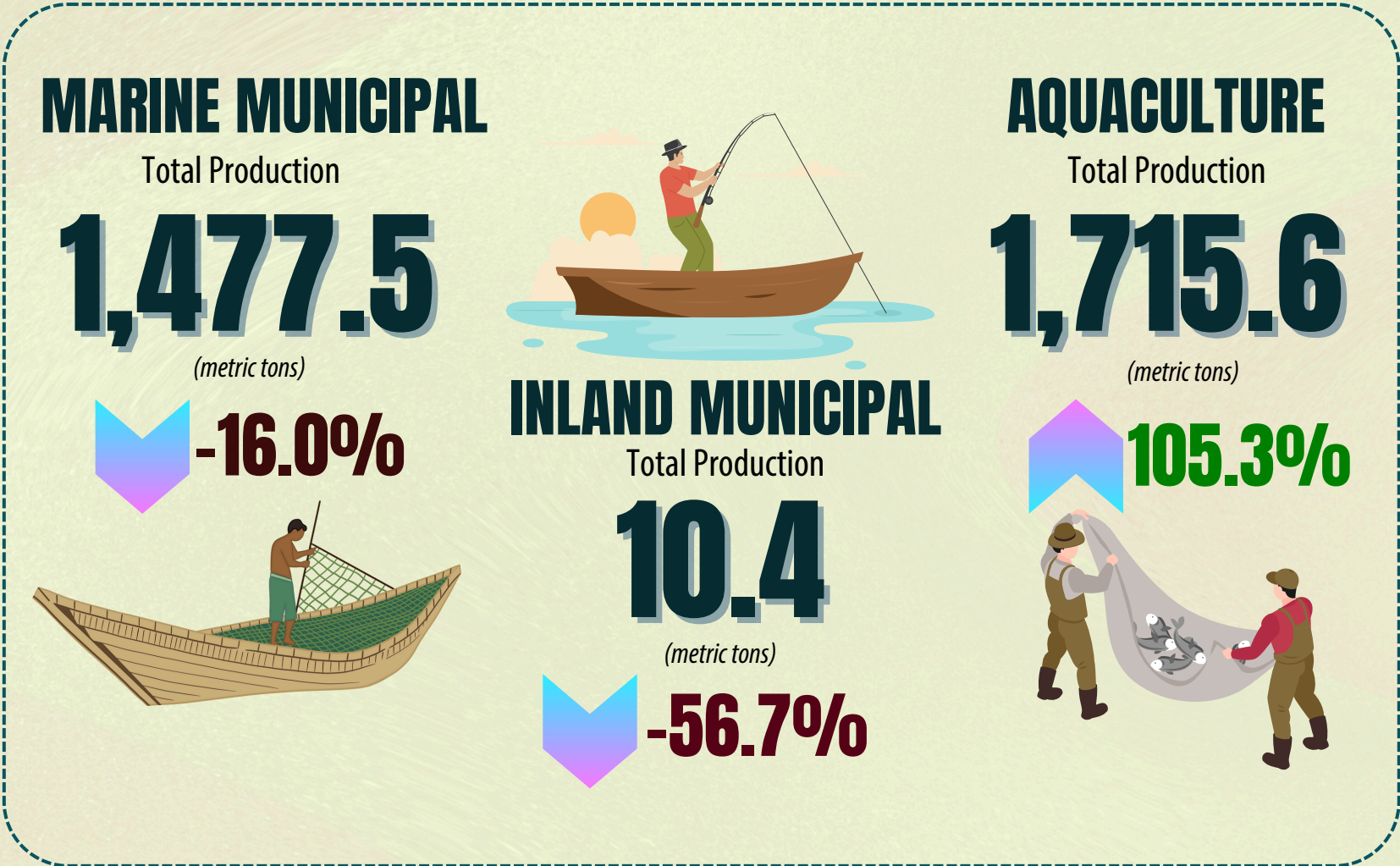
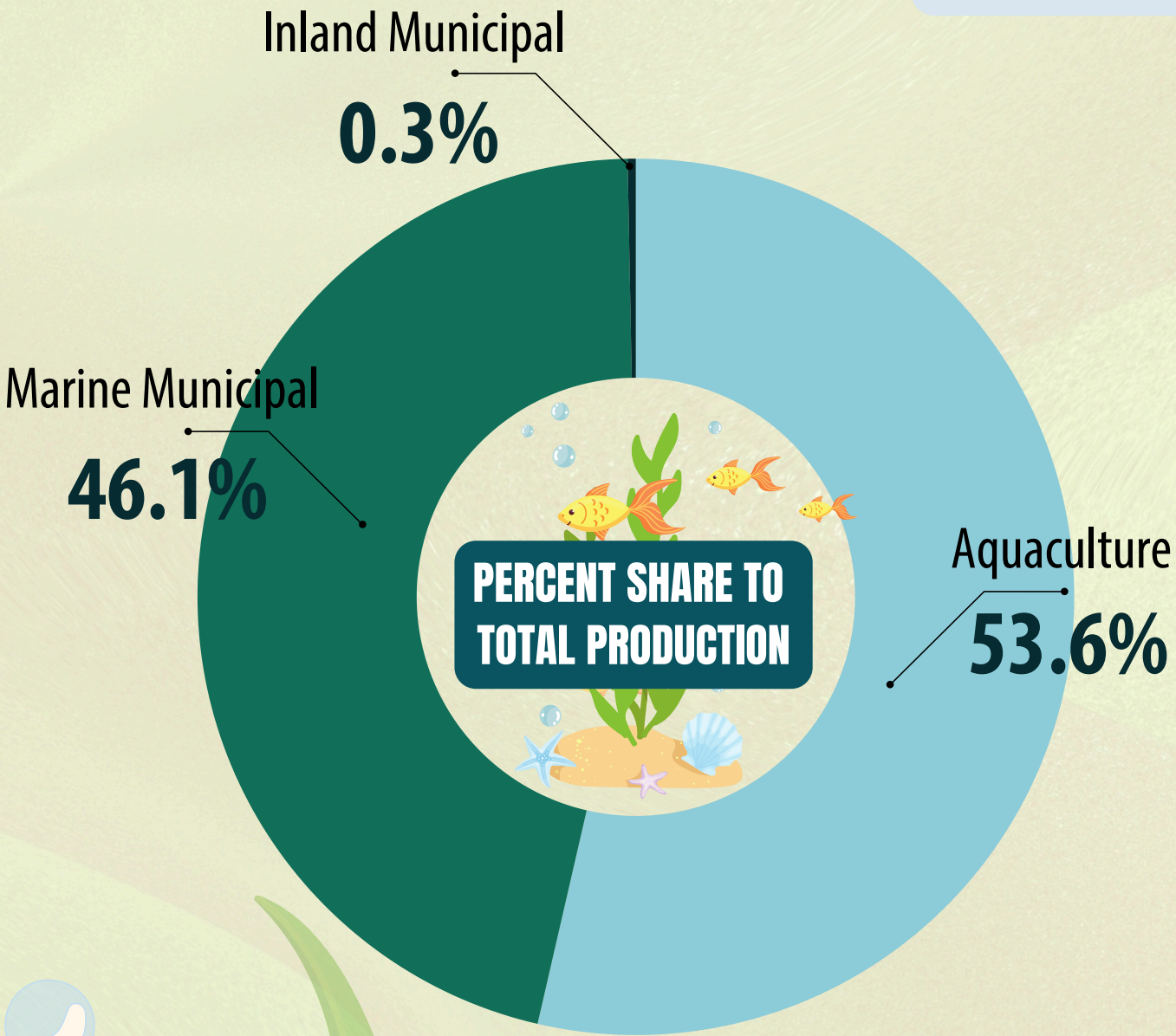

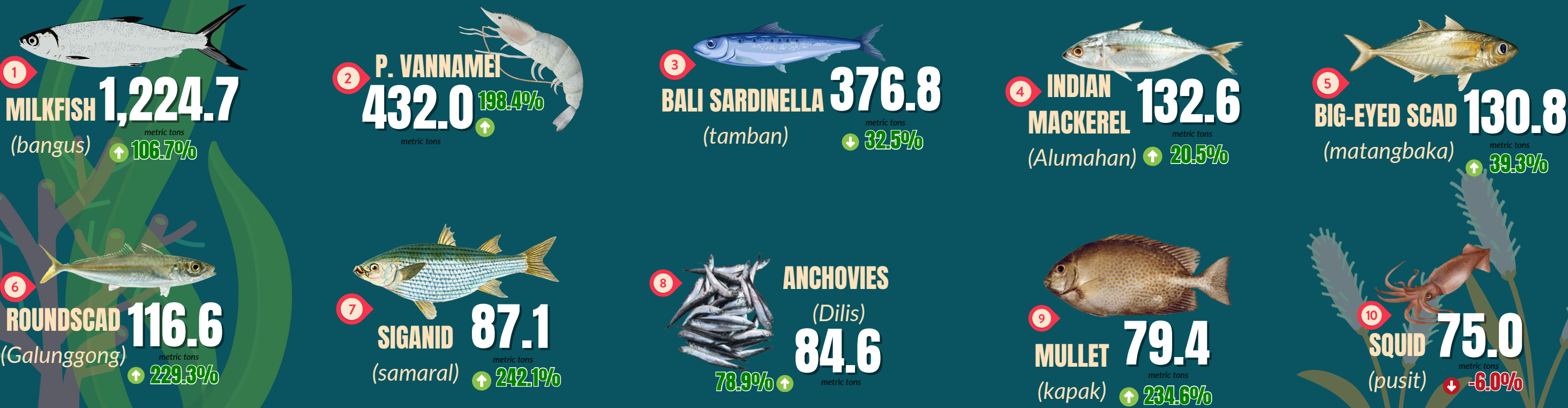

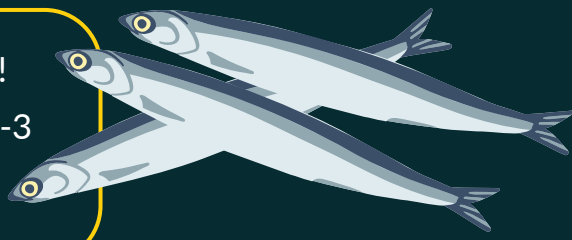
TOP 10 SPECIES IN TERMS OF VOLUME OF PRODUCTION

Anchovies (*Stolephorus insularis* and *Stolephorus indicus*)

Anchovy production in Davao de Oro reached 84.6 metric tons in 2024 — a 78.9% increase from the previous year! A member of the Engraulidae family, anchovies are small, schooling fish known for their distinct salty flavor, high omega-3 content, and role in both local dishes like bagoong and international cuisine. Despite their size, anchovies play a big role in nutrition and fisheries production! 🐟🌊
