About 80 PSA, BFP, and PSC member agencies personnel participated in the motorcade to kick off the 34th NSM, held at the major thoroughfares of the Poblacion area in Nabunturan last 02 October 2023.

This year, PSA Davao de Oro successfully opened the 34th National Statistics Month (NSM) with a motorcade last 02 October 2023. About 50 regular personnel, contract of service workers (COSWs), and Statistical Researchers (SRs) participated along the major streets of the Poblacion area of Nabunturan.
