Unregistered Births in Nabunturan Population (2020 Census of Population and Housing)

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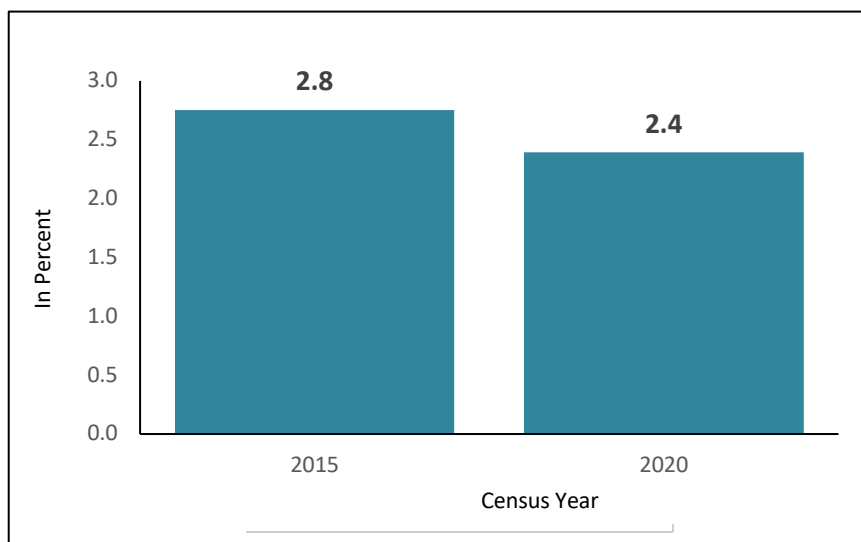
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Proportion of persons with unregistered births in Nabunturan decreases to 2.4 percent

The 2020 Census of Population and Housing (2020 CPH) revealed that a total of 2,014 persons of the household population in 2020 had their births unregistered with the Local Civil Registry Office (LCRO) of Nabunturan. This is equivalent to 2.4 percent of the 84,233 household population in 2020. (Figure 1)

Moreover, census results from 2015 to 2020 show a decreasing trend in the proportion of persons with unregistered births, from 2.8 percent to 2.4 percent in 2020. The 2020 figure is lower by 0.4 percentage point. (Figure 1)

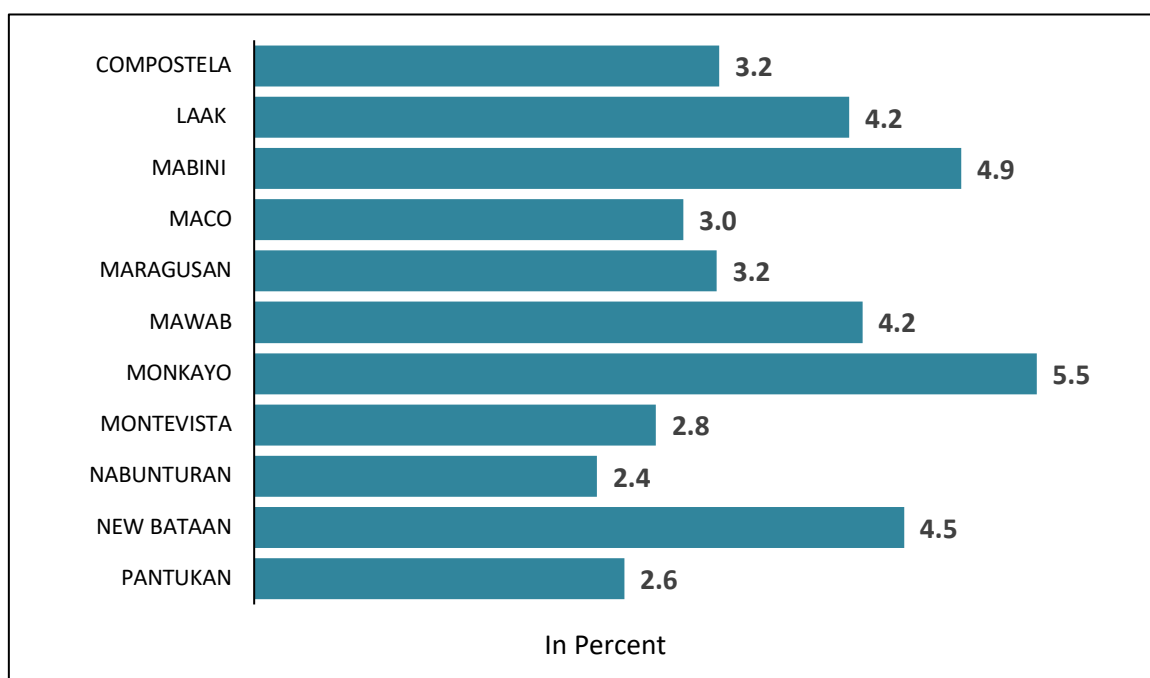


Nabunturan is lowest in the proportion of persons with unregistered births

In 2020, Davao de Oro reported a 3.6 percent of the household population whose births were unregistered with the LCROs. At the municipal level, Monkayo posted the highest with 5.5 percent of the household population. This was followed by Mabini with 4.9 percent and New Bataan with 4.5 percent. (Figure 2)

Two other municipalities posted a proportion higher than the provincial level, namely, Laak and Mawab. (Figure 2)

On the other hand, Nabunturan posted the lowest proportion of persons with unregistered births (2.4%) translating to 2,014 of the total household population, followed by Pantukan (2.6%), Montevista (2.8%) and Maco (3.0%). (Figure 2)

Proportion of persons with unregistered births is highest in Basak; lowest in Ogao

Among the 28 barangays, Basak posted the highest proportion of the household population whose births were reported to be unregistered at 6.4 percent, corresponding to 173 persons out of the 2,699 household population in the barangay. Magsaysay followed with 4.8 percent (297 persons) and Linda with 4.7 percent (134 persons). (Table 1 and Figure 3)

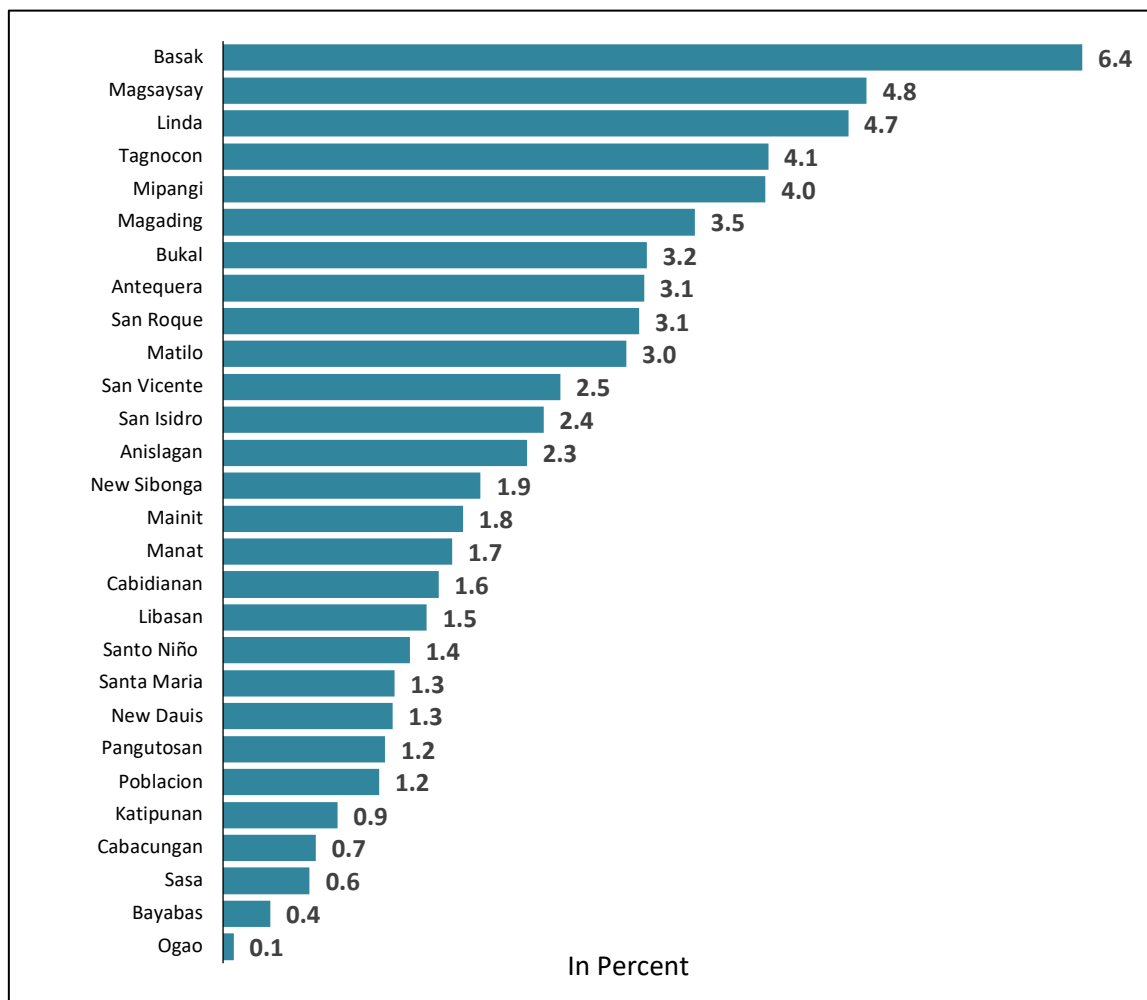

Meanwhile, Ogao recorded the lowest proportion of unregistered births, at 0.1 percent, followed by Bayabas (0.4%), Sasa (0.6%), and Cabacungan (0.7%). (Table 1 and Figure 3)

Figure 3. Proportion of the Household Population with Unregistered Births: Nabunturan, 2020



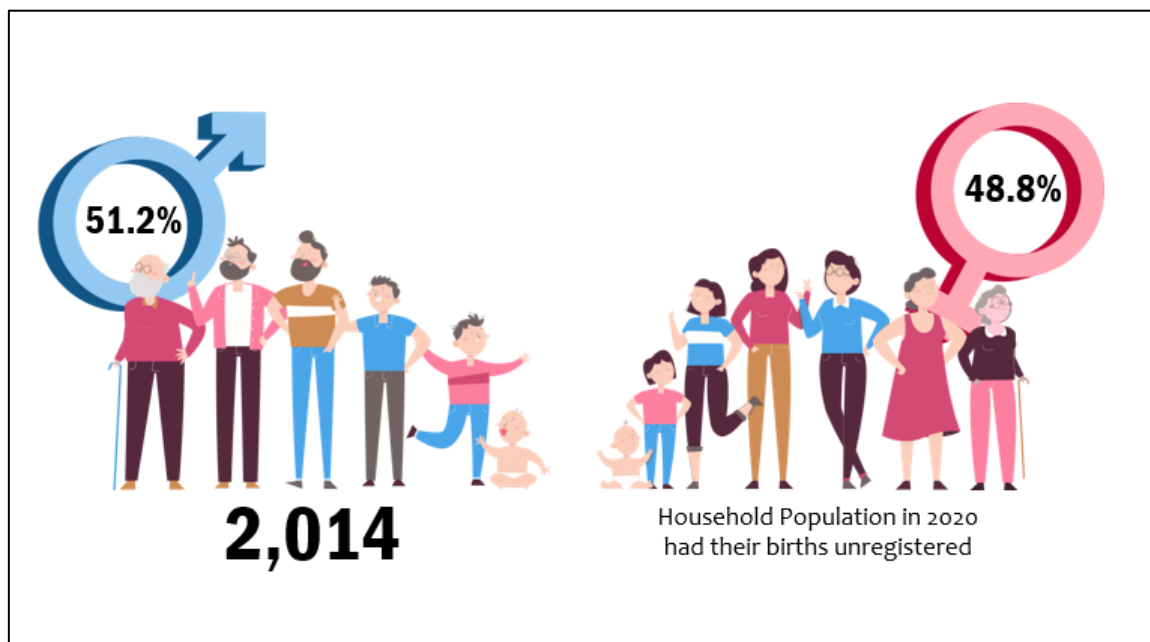

More males than females have unregistered births

Among the 2,014 household population whose births were unregistered with the LCRO, 51.2 percent (1,031) were males, while 48.8 percent (983) were females. This translates to a sex ratio of 105 males whose births were unregistered with the LCRO for every 100 females whose births were also unregistered. (Figure 4)

Figure 4. Distribution of the Household Population with Unregistered Birth by Sex: Nabunturan, 2020



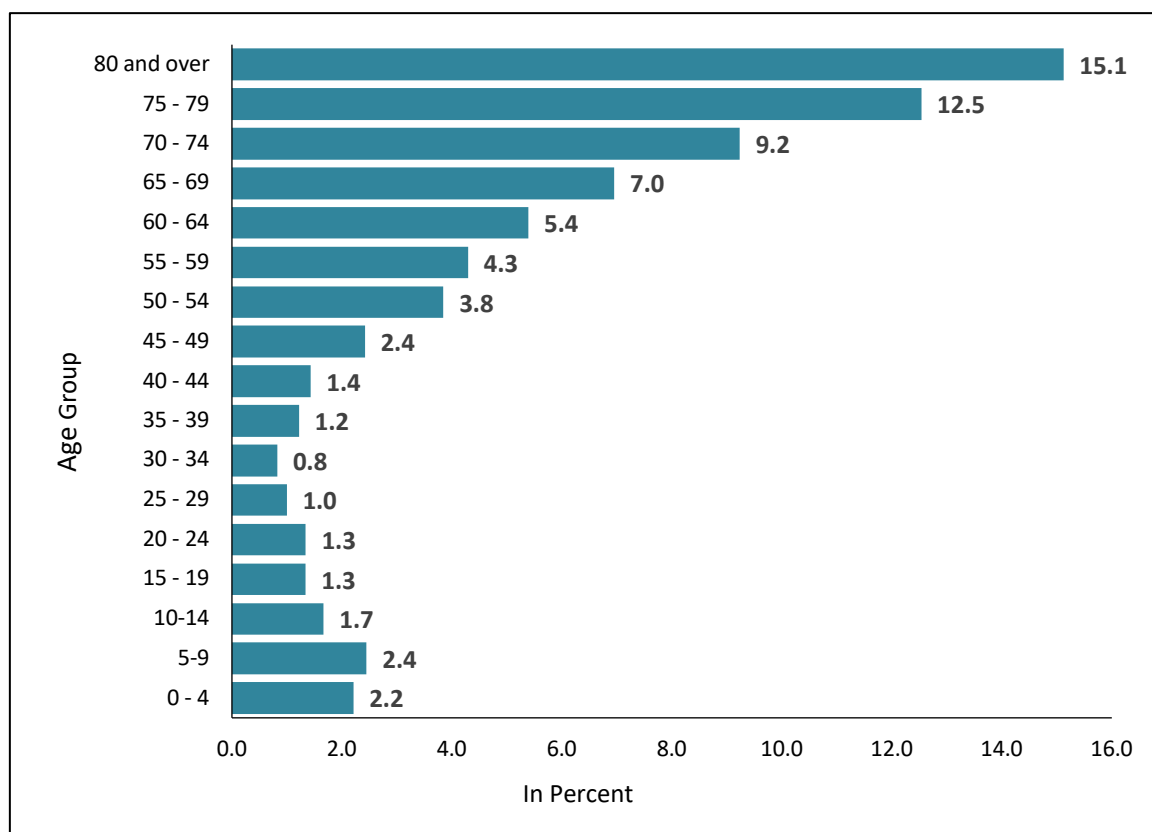

At the barangay level, Basak which had the highest proportion whose births were unregistered with the LCRO also showed a higher percentage of males at 52.0 percent compared to females at 48.0 percent.

The oldest age groups post the highest proportions of unregistered births

Across age groups, the household population aged 80 years old and over had the highest proportion of unregistered births at 15.1 percent. The high proportion was also noted in the age group 75-79 years (12.5%), followed by those in the age groups 70-74 years (9.2%), 65-69 years (7.0%), and 60-64 years (5.4%). In contrast, the lowest proportion was recorded in the age group 30-34 years at 0.8 percent. (Figure 5)

In addition, about 8.0 percent or 602 persons out of 7,482 aged 60 years and above were reported in the census to have unregistered births. This means that eight (8) in 100 senior citizens have unregistered births. (Figure 5)

Tagnocon posts the highest proportion of persons who never had a copy of their birth certificates

While 2.4 percent of the household population revealed that their births were unregistered, about 4.5 percent reported that they never had a copy of their birth certificates. A total of 3,779 persons of the 84,233 household population were reported to never had a copy of their birth certificates. (Table 2 and Figure 6)

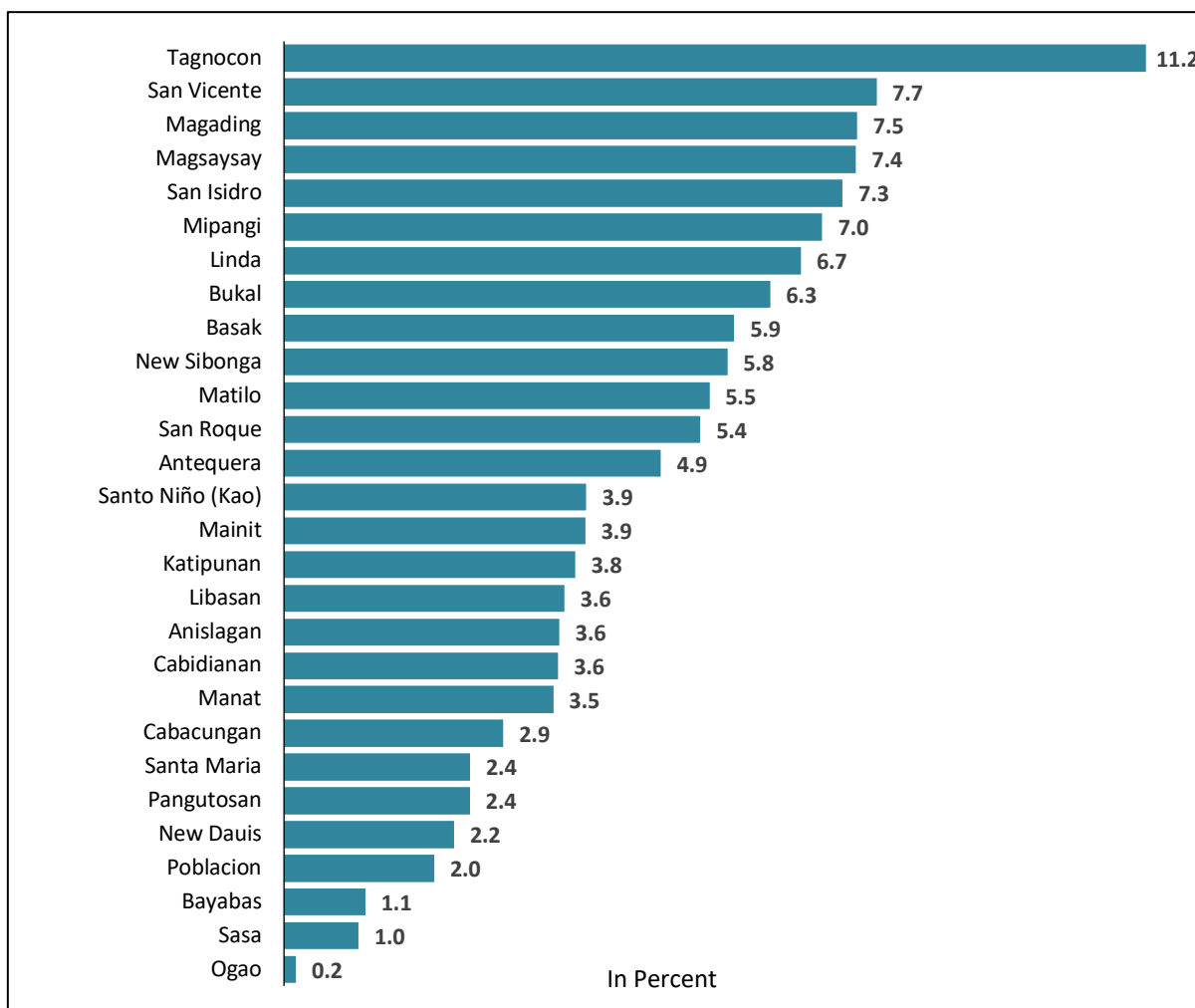

Among the 28 barangays, Tagnocon recorded the highest proportion of household population who never had a copy of their birth certificates, 11.2 percent or 328 persons. It was followed by San Vicente (7.7%), Magading (7.5%), and Magsaysay (7.4%). (Table 2 and Figure 6)

Ogao posted the lowest proportion of persons who never had a copy of their birth certificates at 0.2 percent, followed by Sasa at 1.0 percent, and Bayabas at 1.1 percent. (Table 2 and Figure 6)

TECHNICAL NOTES

The statistics presented in this Special Release were based on the answers and information provided by the respondent or any responsible member of the household to the questions on birth registration about all the household members.

For the 2020 CPH, birth registration data of all household members were collected by asking the respondents, *“Was _____’s birth registered with the Local Civil Registry Office?”* and *“Has _____ ever had a copy of his/her birth certificate?”*
