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Go-Live Launching of PSA Managed CRS Outlet in Nabunturan

A new chapter in public service delivery opened as the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Davao de Oro officially launched its first PSA Managed Civil Registry System (CRS) Outlet in the province, located at BMP Surebuild Building, M. Fuentes Avenue, Poblacion, Nabunturan last 27 May 2025.

The Go-Live Launching commenced with a solemn blessing and ceremonial ribbon-cutting, followed by the start of client transactions. Hon. Mayor Myrocel C. Balili of Nabunturan became the outlet's first official client, receiving her Certificate of Live Birth in under ten minutes.

"Mangadlawon ta sa una moadto sa Davao, pero karon dali na lang kaayo," Mayor Balili remarked, lauding the outlet's efficiency and accessibility. She also highlighted PSA's consistent partnership in the LGU's outreach efforts, especially in far-flung areas.

The Nabunturan CRS outlet is the second PSA Managed CRS outlet in the country and forms part of the Civil Registry System – Information Technology Project Phase 2 (CRS-ITP2), further advancing PSA's goal of smarter, faster, and more accessible civil registration services.

Services Offered at Nabunturan CRS Outlet

With a service capacity of up to 200 walk-in clients daily, the newly launched PSA Managed CRS Outlet in Nabunturan brings vital civil registration services closer to residents of Davao de Oro and nearby municipalities.

The outlet is part of PSA's digital transformation initiative under CRS-ITP2, providing clients with a more convenient and technology-enhanced registration experience.

The outlet offers a full suite of civil registry services, including:

- Copy issuance and authentication of **Birth, Marriage, and Death Certificates**
- Issuance of **Certificate of No Marriage (CENOMAR)** and **Certificate of No Death (CENODEATH)**
- Access to Viewable Online Records and DocPrint Services

The PSA extended heartfelt thanks to the Municipal Government of Nabunturan for its full support in implementing BRAP and strengthening civil registration at the grassroots level.

National ID Registration Goes Home to Maragusan's Senior Citizen

National ID Registration Team of the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Davao de Oro conducted a special house-to-house National ID registration for senior citizens in the municipality of Maragusan who are unable to visit registration centers due to old age, illness, or limited mobility.

The activity was carried out in coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Maragusan through the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) to assist senior citizens in preparing documentary requirements for government aid and services. While the National ID is still optional until June 2025, it will be a mandatory requirement starting September 2025, as the National Commission of Senior Citizens (NCSC) takes over the distribution of financial assistance.

The National ID registration team visited elderly clients in their homes across Barangay Poblacion and Barangay Tigbao, reaching bedridden and vulnerable individuals in Purok Ilang-Ilang, Buyo, Narra-A, Caimeto, Aguacan-A, Bulahan, Dahlia, Anthurium, and Secret Love.

Senior citizens warmly welcomed the recent National ID registration outreach, with many expressing joy and gratitude as they finally completed their registration. Due to physical limitations, several lolos and lolas had been unable to travel to registration centers and had long awaited this opportunity. With the success of the outreach activity, they now look forward to receiving the printed digital copy of their National ID, which they can use for various official transactions.

May 2025 LFS with Volunteer Work Successfully Conducted

The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Davao de Oro successfully concluded the 2025 May Round of the Labor Force Survey (LFS) with Rider Questions on Volunteer Work last May 08-28, achieving a remarkable 100 percent response rate across all sampled households.

The survey, which aimed to gather up-to-date statistics on employment, unemployment, underemployment, and volunteerism, was conducted in selected enumeration areas of the province through house-to-house interviews by trained Statistical Researchers.

The provincial statistical office extends its appreciation to all households who participated and to the local government units and barangay officials for their continued support and cooperation in facilitating a smooth and timely data collection process.
