PSA-RSSO XI Holds 2025 LCRO Forum in Davao del Norte

TAGUM CITY, Davao del Norte – The Regional Statistical Services Office XI (PSA-RSSO XI) successfully held the 2025 Local Civil Registry Offices (LCRO) Forum on 29 May 2025, at the Tagum City Historical and Cultural Center.

The forum convened civil registrars and key representatives from local registry offices across the Davao Region, providing a vital platform for dialogue and collaboration on current developments in civil registration. Highlights of the one-day event included updates on registration protocols, clarification of relevant memoranda, and the rollout of auditing procedures aimed at strengthening transparency and compliance among LCROs.

Participants actively took part in open forums and technical consultations, raising operational concerns and sharing field-level insights. In response, RSSO XI committed to facilitating targeted follow-up actions and providing continued support to address identified challenges.

The forum was warmly received, with participants commending the initiative for fostering regional solidarity and enhancing their capacity to deliver efficient and responsive civil registration services.

PSA Extends Birth Registration Services to Remote Communities on Talicud Island

IISLAND GARDEN CITY OF SAMAL, Davao del Norte - In its continued advocacy to promote universal legal identity, the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) – Birth Registration Assistance Project Team, in partnership with the City Civil Registry Office of the Island Garden City of Samal, conducted a successful birth registration outreach in the isolated areas of Barangay Dadatan and Barangay Sta. Cruz, Talicud Island, Kaputian District.

The initiative forms part of PSA's wider efforts to strengthen access to civil registration services and reduce the number of unregistered individuals. The activity was tailored to reach residents with limited mobility and documentation, some of whom had never undergone formal registration.

A total of 40 individuals were directly assisted, taking their first step toward securing legal identity and gaining access to essential public services, including education, health care, and social welfare programs.

The success of the outreach highlights the unwavering commitment of PSA and the local government in advancing the right to identity and inclusion for all, regardless of age or geographic location.

- Assistance in requesting PSA-issued birth and marriage certificates, particularly for first-time job seekers.

The initiative also served as a platform for advocacy, outreach, and support for inclusive digital identity coverage across the province.

Strengthens National ID Awareness at Tagum City ABC Meeting

Information Officer I Charnel Fate C. Albite, served as the resource speaker during the meeting. The presentation focused on vital updates on the implementation of the National ID in Tagum City and emphasized the importance of intensified information dissemination at the barangay level.

One of the main points raised during the discussion was the retrieval of unclaimed National ID cards at the barangay level. IO I Albite inquired whether any IDs remained in the custody of the barangays, emphasizing that, as mandated, all remaining National ID cards will be turned over to and collected at the PSA Provincial Office for proper distribution.

The collaboration between PSA and the barangay officials is seen as a crucial step in addressing challenges related to unclaimed National IDs and in promoting civil registration and identity access.

PSO Davao del Norte Undergoes 2025 Regional Cybersecurity Assessment

They were assisted by PSO-DavNor's Officer-in-Charge Michelle O. Maningo and Registration Officer II Arneil J. Lagansua.

The evaluation covered office facilities, data storage areas, and IT systems to ensure strict compliance with cybersecurity standards. The initiative aims to protect sensitive data, prevent unauthorized access, and strengthen the agency's digital security infrastructure.

This activity forms part of PSA's continuing efforts to enhance its cybersecurity posture and ensure the integrity of its information systems nationwide.

CITY OF TAGUM, Davao del Norte - In a continuing effort to promote inclusive civil registration, PSO -Davao del Norte conducted a targeted orientation on the Birth Registration Assistance Project (BRAP) for leaders of the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) on 27 May, held at the DSWD-Pantawid Pamilya Conference Area in Magugpo East, Tagum City.

The orientation aimed to strengthen the capacity of eleven 4Ps team leaders across the province, ensuring they are well-informed about BRAP's mission to increase birth registration rates among the most vulnerable sectors – including Indigenous Peoples (IPs), Muslim Filipinos, and low-income families.

This recent orientation marks another milestone in PSA's advocacy for universal and inclusive civil registration, and strengthens the role of 4Ps team leaders as community frontliners in spreading awareness and facilitating registration.
