EMPLOYMENT RATE

Not seeking work due to:

- Due to Covid-19 Pandemic Community Quarantine
- Tired or believed no work available;
- Awaiting results of previous job application;
- Temporary illness or disability;

- Waiting for rehire or job recall

LABOR FORCE PARTICIPATION RATE

of the population 15-years old and over as of their last birthday are **UNDEREMPLOYED**

UNDEREMPLOYED

An underemployed person refers to employed persons who expressed the desire to have additional hours of work in their present job, or to have additional job, or to have a new job with longer working hours during the reference week.

NOT IN THE LABOR FORCE

Persons not in the labor force are those individuals 15 years old and over who are neither employed, nor unemployed. Also included are persons who are not available and are not looking for work because of the following reasons:

Retired b

Permanent disability c

Household, family duties, and d

Schooling e
