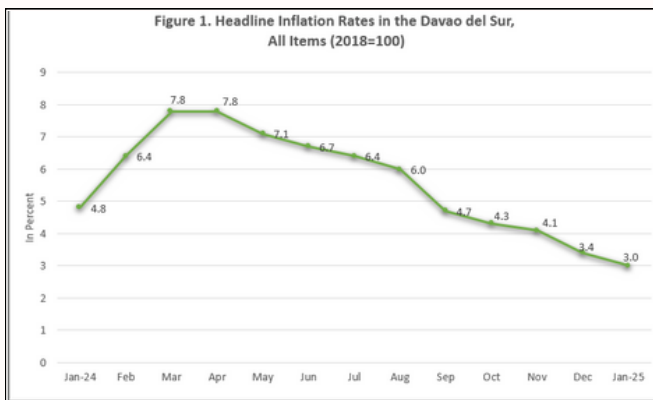
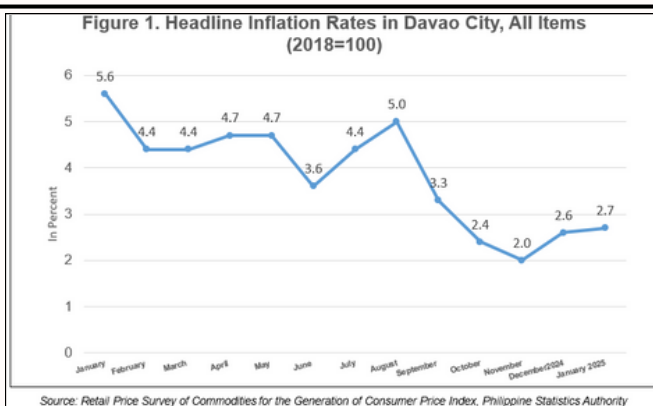

JANUARY 2025 INFLATION REPORT: RESULTS FOR DAVAO CITY AND DAVAO DEL SUR

The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) – Davao del Sur Provincial Statistical Office, led by (SSS) OIC Adeline G. Batucan, presented the January 2025 Inflation Report for Davao City and Davao del Sur via Google Meet and Facebook Live, with 25 participants in attendance.

Davao City's inflation rate is 2.7%, driven by rising food and transport costs, while Davao del Sur saw a higher rate of 3.0%, primarily due to changes in housing and utility costs. Core inflation stands at 2.3% for Davao City and 4.8% for Davao del Sur, highlighting varying inflation pressures in both locations.

This report is conducted monthly to provide awareness to the general public and users on the significance of inflation in daily life.
