


PSA DAVAO DEL SUR BEGINS ITS OPERATION FOR 2024 POPCEN-CBMS SERVICE FACILITIES AND GOVERNMENT PROJECTS



On March 10, 2025, the PSA Davao del Sur officially initiated the map data collection phase for the 2024 Census of Population and Community-Based Monitoring System (POPCEN-CBMS) Service Facilities and Government Projects (SFGP). This initial stage of the operation involved on-the-ground data gathering within both the geographical boundaries of the Davao City and Davao del Sur. The whole operation, including the map data processing and map data reviewing, is expected to end on the month of April 2025.

This ensured that communities and local agencies in the City of Davao and Davao del Sur will have access to upto-date and reliable information to support important decision-making.





PSA DAVAO DEL SUR CONDUCTS FIELD SUPERVISION FOR 2024 INTERNATIONAL COMPARISON PROGRAM (ICP) RETAIL PRICE SPOT-CHECKING

From March 17 to 21, 2025, PSA Davao del Sur conducted its first field supervision on 2024 International Comparison Program Retail Price Spot-Checking in Davao City, led by SS I Maria Jose Aubrey A. Nequinto of Price Statistics Division, with assistance from SS II Imelda V. Abdala and COSW PLDS Statistical Analyst Alexa Joy B. Canteros. The team visited various outlets like Bankerohan Public Market, Gaisano Mall, and Agdao Public Market to verify prices for various goods, overcoming minor challenges to ensure efficient data collection.

Additionally, the team expanded their visits to other outlets like Yamaha, Kymco, and Savemore to verify prices for motorcycles, mobile phones, and home goods. during the supervision activities. Overall, the supervision for the 2024 ICP Spot-Checking of Retail Prices of Commodities was productive and successful. It ensured the accuracy and consistency of price data collection, strengthened the capacity of field personnel, and reinforced the importance of quality assurance in statistical operations.





PSA DAVAO DEL SUR CONTINUES NATIONAL ID R IN SANTA CRUZ, DAVAO DEL SUR

PSA Davao del Sur, in coordination with the Department Social Welfare of and Development (DSWD) Region XI, conducted a National ID registration for Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) beneficiaries in Barangay Astorga, Santa Cruz, Davao del Sur. Held as part of the Family Development Session (FDS) Equivalency Program, the activity successfully registered three hundred seventy-six (376) beneficiaries, including adults and children.

This was a month-long schedule of National ID registration activities to prioritize the registration of 4Ps members in the National Identification System.
