**Definition of Terms:**

**Consumer Price Index (CPI)** - an indicator of the change in the average retail prices of a fixed basket of goods and services commonly purchased by households relative to a base year.

**Inflation Rate** - year-on-year changes in the CPI.

**Labor Force Participation Rate** - proportion of total labor force to the total household population 15 years and over.

**Purchasing Power of Peso** – a measure of the value of the peso in each period relative to a chosen reference period.

**Provincial Product Accounts** – is a mechanism to compile the Gross Provincial Domestic Product and Gross City Domestic Product. It is viewed to measure the economic performance at the provincial level and to monitor economic development or progress.

**Gross City Domestic Product** – is the monetary value of all goods and services produced within a city's border in a given period.

**Poverty Incidence** – the proportion of families/individuals with per capita income/expenditure less than the per capita poverty threshold to the total number of families/individuals.

**Subsistence Incidence** – the proportion of families/individuals with per capita income/expenditure less than the per capita food threshold to the total number of families/individuals.

**Employment Rate** - proportion of employed persons to the total labor force. Unemployment Rate - proportion of unemployed persons to the total labor force.

**Underemployment Rate** - proportion of underemployed persons to total employed persons.

Poverty Incidence among Population - refers to the proportion of population with per capita income less than the per capita poverty threshold to the total number of populations.
