RANDOM CHECK AND AUDIT AT LOCAL CIVIL REGISTRY OFFICE (LCRO)



Pursuant to Section 11 of Republic Act (RA) No. 10625 relative to the inspection and visitorial powers of the National Statistician and Civil Registrar General (NSCRG), the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) is mandated to ensure compliance with civil registration laws and to uphold the standards of service delivery across all Local Civil Registry Offices (LCROs).

In line with this mandate, The Philippine Statistics Authority-Davao Occidental conducted a random check and audit last 21 May 2025 at the Local Civil Registry Office (LCRO), Sta. Maria, Davao Occidental. The visit aimed to assess the accuracy, completeness and efficiency of civil registry operations and evaluate adherence to PSA regulations.

The audit was facilitated by the PSA Davao Occidental personnel headed by Chief Statistical Specialist Mr. Jessie A. Madulin.

The team reviewed the following areas: Document Acceptance/Receipt and Control System, Encoding using PhilCRIS or other LCRO system, Review and Verification, Signing and Registration/Approvals, Registry Book Entry/Registry Books, Archiving/ Binding/ Folioing/ Storage/ Access, Batch Request System (BREQS) Processing at the LCROs.

The audit and random check served as a valuable opportunity to support operational improvement and reinforce compliance with national standards. The PSA Davao Occidental Provincial Statistical Office audit team commended the LCRO Sta. Maria for its cooperation and commitment to efficient civil registration services.
