National ID Focal Person Al-Stephen Hervas presented vital updates on the National Identification System, emphasizing the rebranding of the Philippine Identification (PhilID) to National ID in accordance with the latest policies.



PPF Hervas discussed the three formats of the National ID, which include the physical National ID card, the ePhilID/National ID in paper format, and the Digital National ID. He highlighted the system's enhanced security features, streamlined public service access, and the ongoing efforts to replace National IDs with peeled-off photos.
