Strengthens Integrity of Functional Identification: PSA Davao Occidental Continues National ID Registration for Children Aged 1-4

The Philippines Statistics Authority is the lead agency mandated in carrying out the provisions in implementing the Philippine Identification System (PhilSys). In line with this, the Davao Occidental Provincial Statistical Office headed by Supervising Statistical Specialist, Officer incharge Munria L. Banto strengthen its commitment to register 92 million Filipinos by the end of September 2024 on PhilSys.

In connection to this, the PhilSys Davao Occidental initiates a Schools and House to house registration which focuses on Child Development Centers in each municipality of the province and a co-location activity with DSWD's 4P's Beneficiaries. Furthermore, the PhilSys team started registering children 1-4 years old last February 2024. By the end of September 2024, PSA Davao Occidental registered a total of 282,180 individuals in which 7,126 of these are children ages 1-4 years old.
