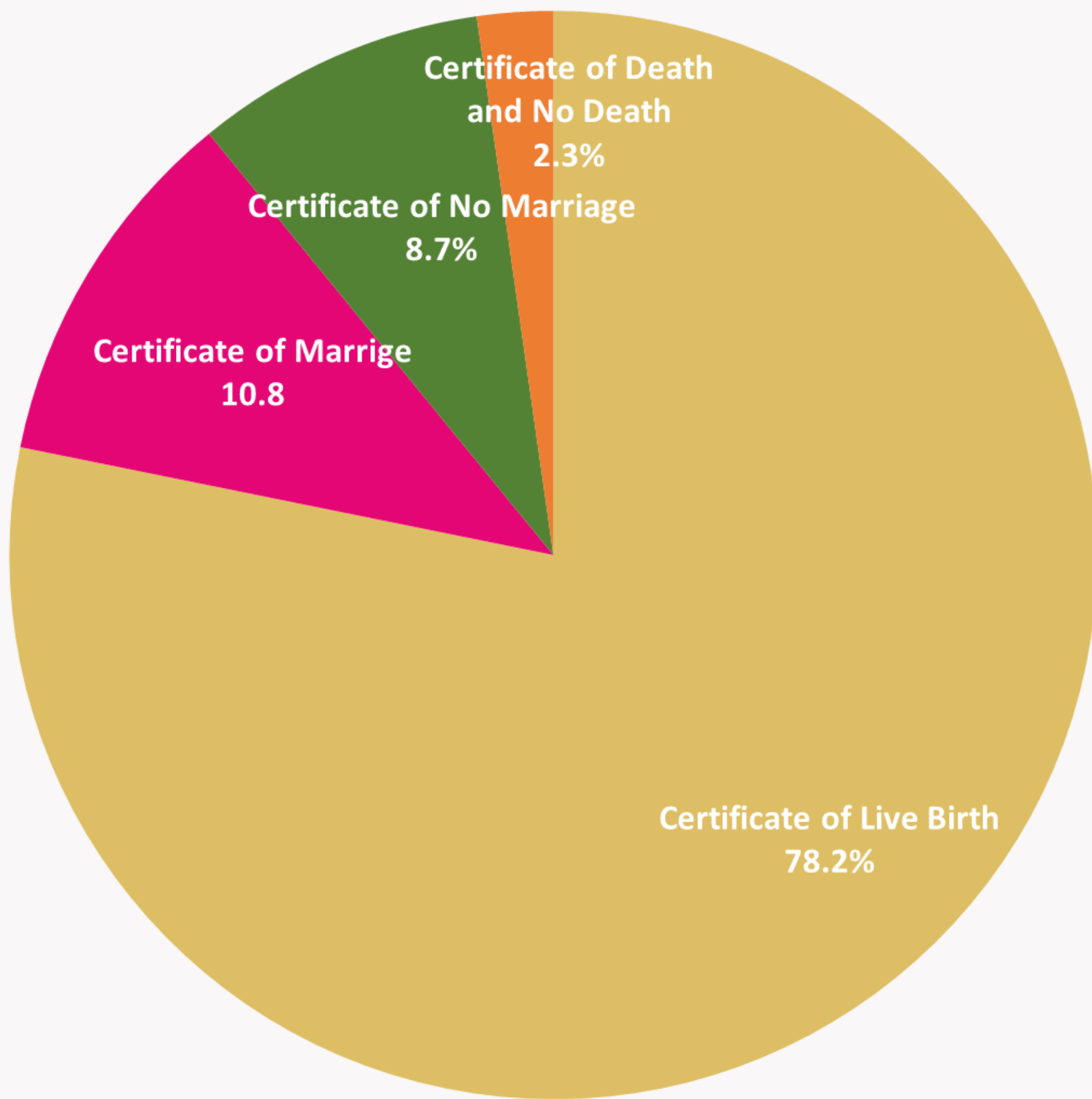

Technical Notes:

LIVE BIRTH is the complete expulsion or extraction from its mother of a product of conception, irrespective of the duration of the pregnancy, which after such separation, breathes or shows any other evidence of life, such as beating of the heart, pulsation of the umbilical cord, or definite movement of voluntary muscles, whether or not the umbilical cord has been cut or the placenta is attached; each product of such a birth is considered liveborn.

CERTIFICATE OF NO MARRIAGE (CENOMAR) is a certification issued by the PSA stating that a person has not contracted any marriage. It is also called a Certificate of No Record of Marriage or Certificate of Singleness. In legal definitions for interpersonal status, a single person is someone who has never been married.

CERTIFICATE OF MARRIAGE is a contract of permanent union between a man and a woman entered into in accordance with law for the establishment of conjugal and family life.

CERTIFICATE OF NO DEATH is a certification issued by the PSA stating that there is no record of death in the Civil Registry System (CRS) Database.

CERTIFICATE OF DEATH refers to the permanent disappearance of all evidence of life at any time after live birth has taken place (postnatal cessation of vital function without capability of resuscitation).
