
This means that if you spent 100 pesos on goods and services in 2018, the same goods and services will cost you 119.3 pesos in February 2023.

The Consumer Price Index (CPI) is an indicator of the change in the average retail prices of a fixed basket of goods and commonly services purchased households relative to a base year.
