“Effective procedures and measures can save lives”

Fire safety reduces the risk of injury and building damage that fires can cause. Developing and implementing fire safety protocols in the workplace is vastly significant for it is not just required by law but it is crucial to everyone’s safety and to protect government properties.

To build a fire prevention plan, the PSA – Davao del Norte Provincial Statistical Office (DavNor PSO) conducted a Fire Prevention and Protection Seminar-Workshop in cooperation with the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) Davao del Norte on 17 June 2022.
