Commercial Fisheries

Commercial fisheries cover fishing operations in marine waters that make use of boats of more than three (3) gross tons.

Marine Municipal Fisheries

Marine municipal fisheries covers fishing operations in marine waters within 15 kilometers from the shoreline, either without the use of a fishing boat or with the use of fishing boat with three gross tons or less.

Inland Fisheries

Inland municipal fisheries include catching of fish, crustaceans, mollusks and other aquatic animals and plants in inland water like lakes, rivers, dams, marshes, etc. using fishing vessels of three (3) gross tons or less, or fishing not requiring the use of fishing vessels.

Aquaculture

Aquaculture means propagating and culturing of fish and other aquatic plants and animals in fresh, brackish, and marine water areas. Examples of this are propagating and culturing of fish and shrimps in fish ponds and fish pens, seaweed farm, mussel farm, and oyster farm.

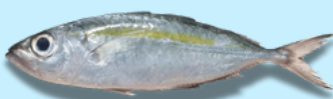
