



CONSUMER PRICE INDEX

The CPI is an indicator of the change in the average retail prices of a fixed basket of goods and services commonly purchased by households relative to a base year.

Bottom 30% Household

Families that belong in the low-income bracket and the most vulnerable to economic and social difficulties.
