

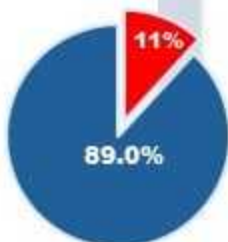

STATUS OF STEP 2 REGISTRATION AS OF 31 MARCH 2025

What is PhilSys?

The Philippine Identification System (PhilSys) established through Republic Act 11055, is the single national identification system for all Filipinos and resident aliens.



As of 31 March 2025, Davao Oriental has successfully registered 519,544 individuals, or 90.1% of the population of 576,343, based on the 2020 Census of Population and Housing.

What is Step 2 Registration?

It is the validation of supporting documents and collection of biometric information such as iris scan, fingerprints and front-facing photograph.

The City of Mati achieved the highest Step 2 output, recording a total of 1,467, whereas San Isidro had the lowest Step 2 output with 143.

Number of Registrants per Municipality as of 31 March 2025



With a total of 141,997 registered individuals, the City of Mati has the highest number of registrants, while Boston has the lowest with only 13,275 registered persons.
