
The headline inflation in the region inched upward to 9.9 percent in February 2023 from 9.4 percent in January 2023.

INFLATION RATE

is the annual rate of change or on-year change in the **CONSUMER PRICE** INDEX (CPI) expressed in percent.

is an indicator of the change in the average retail prices of a fixed basket of goods and services commonly purchased by households relative to a base year. The CPI for All Income Households was rebased from Base Year 2012 to Base Year 2018.

PURCHASING POWER OF PESO (PPP)
is a measure of the real value of peso in a
given period relative to a chosen reference
period. It is computed by getting the reciprocal of the CPI and multiplying the result by 100.







PURCHASING POWER OF PESO (PPP)
