TECHNICAL NOTES

Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Bottom 30% Income Households measures changes in the average consumer prices of selected goods and services commonly purchased by the bottom 30% income households.

Inflation Rate

is the annual rate of change or the year-on-year change in the CPI expressed in percent. Inflation is interpreted in terms of declining purchasing power of the peso.
